In compliances of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of right under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land 'proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 where in MoEF's issued certain relaxation in respect, it is certified that (Separate list enclosed) regarding name of village, Sr. No. and Area of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **Sub Divisional Officer, Saoner District Nagpur for Forest Right Act 2006 (I- Diversion of 216.33 ha. Fragmented Zudpi Jungle for Public purpose / public infrastructure in Consolidated)** from using simplified procedure of **Saoner Tahsil in Nagpur District** falls within jurisdiction of village (List of villages enclosed) in Saoner tahsil.

**It is further certified that :**

- a) the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for entire Total **area-216.33 hectares** of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meeting of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.


- b) the proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular / local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- c) the each of concerned Gram sabha(s), has certified that all formalities / processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the proposed and details of proposed diversion. All copies of resolution issued by all concerned Gram sabha(s) of Saoner Taluka are enclosed.
- d) the discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- e) the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the concerned Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- f) the right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, Where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1)(e) of the FRA.
