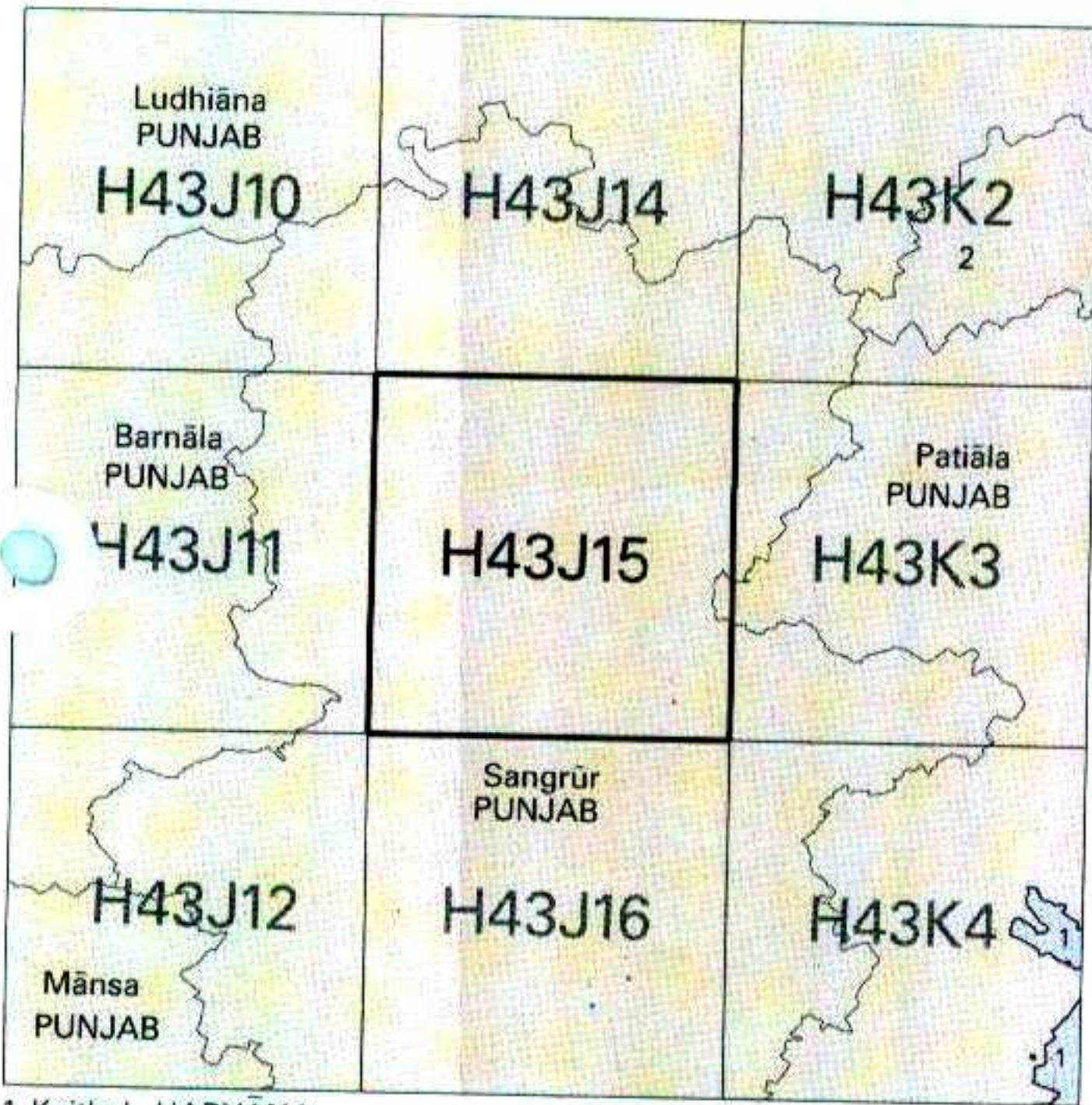

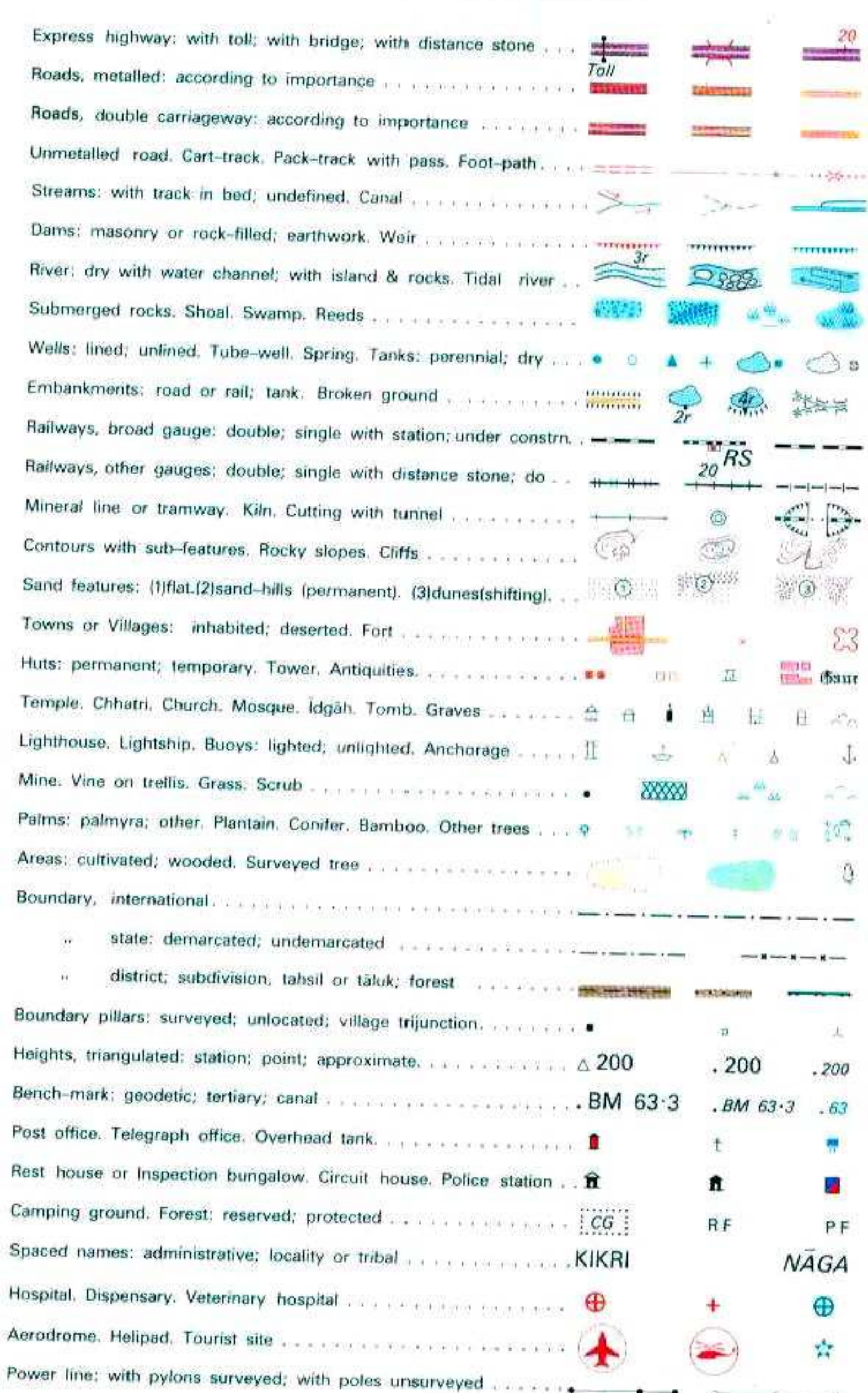

NOTES

Distance stones along Barnala, Sangrur, Shoran Distributaries, Kotla Branch (SIRINDO CANAL) are 5000 ft apart, along Bhagwanpura Distributary are 2 mile apart and every existing stone is shown, whereas other canals, drains, embankments, and distributaries, these are 1000 feet apart and every fifth existing stone is shown.
Permission to use cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
Relative height, 2r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a slope.
Relative height, e.g., 2r, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment on the adjacent country.
We-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
Wells, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
