

DC(SPT)14/10/Electricity: <sup>1282</sup> In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF) Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 14.742 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Manipur State Power Company Limited for the "Construction of 132KV Link Transmission line for Evacuation of Power from 400/132KV Sub-Station at Thoubal to 132 KV Sub-Station at Kongba, Yaingangpokpi and Hundung on existing 132KV line from Kongba to Kakching on turnkey basis", which will pass through the forest areas near Poirou Khngjin, Lisamlok and Keirambi under Sadar Hills of Senapati District.

- (a) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural Communities.
