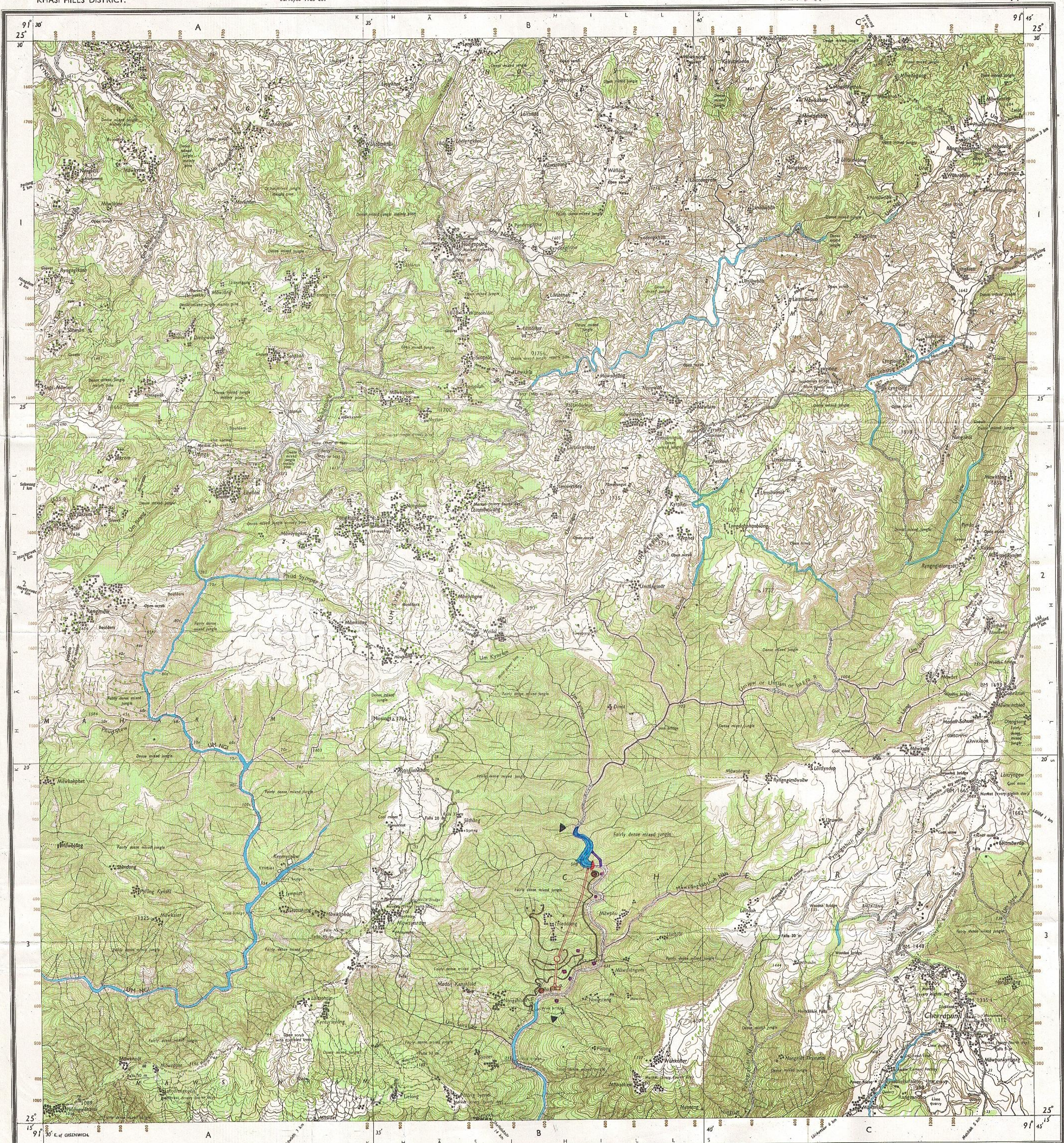

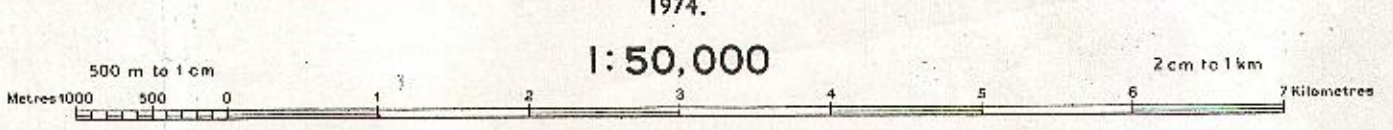

The kilometre stone numbers along roads are shown in slant type, e.g. '3' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. '3'.
Palm or temporarily cultivated areas occur throughout the jungle; they are normally abandoned after 2-3 years and are not shown.
