


CHECKLIST NO. 10

Justification for locating the project in the forest area

2.41 ha of forest land is required for the Construction of motorable Link road from Mani Jhulara (Triya to Kuthed Khas) Km. 8/0 to 11/500 KM. 0/0 to 11/500. The total length of the road is 3.500 Km. out of which 3.115 Km. of the road is pass through forest land and 0.385 Km. passes through non-forest land. This road is being constructed to provide motor link to village Kuthed. The road will cater to the needs of population of about 1332 and will give a boost to the local economy. For the construction of this road and dumping site 2.41 ha. area of forest land is required to be diverted. The Joint Inspection report attached at page No. 56-58

Three number alternatives which were technically feasible were explored. Since all the beneficiary villages are surrounded by forest hence all the three number alignments have to be necessarily pass through forest area if the primary objective of Linking the village to the motor road is to be achieved. Hence there is no escape from using the forest land. Out of the three number alignments the one which involves lesser number of forest land as well as trees has been finalized for construction of road.
