SIARMAL OPEN CAST PROJECT

REHABILITATION AND RESETTLEMENT PLAN

The lands belonging to village Siarmal (full), Gopalpur (Part), Ratansara(Part), Jhupurunga (full), Kulda (part) and Tumulia (part)d of Hemgir Tahasil, District-Sundargarh, Odisha are involved in Siarmal OCP. The Siarmal Open Cast Project includes the Mining Area, Safety zone and Blasting Zone Area.

Total 2290.449 Ha (5659.70 acres) of land is involved in Siarmal OCP. Out of which 1491.898 Ha is tenancy land, 448.843 Ha is Govt. (NF) land, 349.709 Ha is Revenue forest land. The mining area is 1589.142 Ha only. Safety Zone area is 18.59 Ha. The rest area will be for safe blasting zone, embankment and external OB dump.

Out of **1491.898** Ha of tenancy land involved in this project, 83.933 Ha (207.40 acres) belongs to village Siarmal, 385.16 Ha (951.75 acres) belongs to village Gopalpur, 142.921 Ha (353.16 acres) belongs to village Ratansara, 542.970 Ha (1341.68 acre) belongs to village Jhupurunga, 10.307 Ha (25.47 acres) belongs to village Kulda and 326.596 Ha (807.02 acres) belongs to village Tumulia. The lands of all above villages have been acquired under CBA (A&D) Act, 1957 vide Notification u/s 9(1) of the said Act vide SO No. 1869 dated 10.07.1989 and S.O. No. 3055 dated 29.10.1990. The above land has been vested in MCL u/s 11(1) of the said Act vide SO No. 2592 dated 13.09.1990 and 43015 dated 30.03.1993.

The payment of Compensation and R&R benefits for the village Siarmal, Gopalpur, Ratansara, Jhupurunga, Kulda and Tumulia including other 08 villages have been under taken by the Claims Commission, set up by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP© 6933 of 2007. The compensation for land and structures for village Siarmal, Gopalpur, Kulda has been disbursed to the beneficiaries. For village Jhupurunga the Compensation package is under finalization by Hon'ble Claims Commission. For village Tumulia and Ratansara Survey has been completed by the Claims Commission. The assessment and finalization of draft Compensation roll for these two villages (Tumulia and Ratansara) is under process.

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Rehabilitation and Resettlement benefits are being provided to the displaced and affected families of village Siarmal, Gopalpur, Kulda under Orissa R&R Policy 2006 as per recommendation of the Hon'ble Claims Commission and approval of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

For extending R&R benefits to the villagers of Jhupurunga the Project affected families (PAF List) is under finalization by Claims Commission. For village Tumulia and Ratansara the project affected families list (PAF list) under finalization by MCL and then it will be submitted to the Claims Commission for objection hearing, finalization and submission to Hon'ble Supreme Court/ High Court of Odisha for approval. After approval of the list the R&R benefits will be given to the villagers of Jhupurunga, Tumulia and Ratansara.

Approximately, **2562** families from these villages will be displaced/affected due to this project as per the approved PAF list of village Siarmal & Gopalpur and Record of Rights/Project report of Siarmal OCP for villages Jhupurunga Tumulia and Ratansara.

Note: The above figure of the families expected to be displaced / affected is based on PAF list of village Siarmal & Gopalpur and the ROR/ Project Report of village Jhupuruna, Tumulia & Ratansara. However, the figure may vary after finalization of PAF list of village Jhupurunga by Claims

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Commission and family survey report of village Tumulia and Ratansara by MCL and subsequent approval.

The Rehabilitation and Re-settlement to the affected families of village Siarmal and Gopalpur are being extended as per the Odisha R&R Policy 2006, recommended by the Claims Commission and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The Rehabilitation and Resettlement of affected families of village Kulda is coved completely under Kulda OCP, so not reflected in this list.

The Rehabilitation and Resettlement to the affected families Jhupurunga, Tumulia and Ratansara will also be given as per the Orissa R&R policy 2006 after approval of the PAF list by Hon'ble Supreme Court/ High Court of Odisha.

Payment of Compensation for land and structures:

The payment of Compensation for land and structures has already been paid to the affected/displaced families of village **Siarmal** and **Gopalpur**. Against village Siarmal, an amount of **57.31** crores has been disbursed against sanction amount of **90.88** crores. Against village Gopalpur, an amount of Rs **335.52** crores has been disbursed out of sanctioned amount of Rs **366.32** crores. For village Jhupururunga, Tumulia and Ratansara the Compensation roll has not been finalized as stated above.

Employment & Resettlement benefits to village Siarmal and Gopalpur.

As per the approved PAF list of village Siarmal there are 126 families under Category-I for employment. Out of which 81 families have been given employment/paid cash in lieu of employment.

Similarly, as per approved list of village **Gopalpur** there are 623 families in Cat-I for employment. Out of them, 483 families are employed/paid cash in lieu of employment/annuity. In other cases the notices have been served to the beneficiaries to join in service/receive payment of cash in lieu of employment.

Further, there are 51 families in Category-III in village Siarmal. Out of which 10 families have been paid cash in lieu of employment @ Rs 7.00 lakhs/family.

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In village Gopalpur there are 109 families are in Cat-III. Out of which 66 families have been paid cash in lieu of employment @ Rs 7.00 lakhs/family.

There are also 29 families in village Siarmal and 67 families in village Gopalpur under Category-V. These families will also be given cash in lieu of employment @Rs 3.50 lakhs/family for employment with resettlement benefits

Further the Hon'ble Supreme Court has sanctioned Monetary Compensation to 29 familes of village Siarmal and 281 families of Gopalpur under category-I who are over aged for employment. They are also offered cash @ Rs 10.00 lakh/family.

For village Jhupurunga, Tumulia and **Ratansara**, the employments as well as cash in lieu of employment/MC will be given after direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court/ High Court of Odisha.

Resettlement of Displaced families of village Siarmal, Gopalpur, Jhupurunga, Tumulia and Ratansara:

In village Siarmal there are 189 families and in village Gopalpur there are, 981 families for Resettlement. Out of them, 8 families of village Siarmal and 383 families of village Gopalpur have opted for cash in lieu of resettlement benefits. They have been paid @ Rs 5, 78,000/family.

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The other displaced families who will not choose for self re-location will be resettled at Chhatenpali, Sarangijharia and Badkhalia. In Sarangijharia village, 109.94 acres of Govt. non forest land has been taken on lease from Govt. of Odisha by MCL. In village Chhatenpali 61.95 acres & in Badkhalia 55.44 acres have been purchased from private owners for establishment of re-settlement site. The development works in Chhatenpali Pocket-A is almost completed and in Pocket-B, it is in progress. In Sarangijharia and Badkhalia sites developmental works in progress.

The Resettlement of displaced families of village Kulda is under taken by Kulda OCP. They have opted for Chhatenpali R&R site.

The re-settlement site for village Jhupurunga, Tumulia and Ratansara will be decided after approval of PAF list by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

As per order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 10.7.2017, MCL will build houses for the displaced families who do not opt for self relocation elsewhere other than resettlement site and who do not opt for construction of houses by themselves. The drawing for the house to be constructed within the Odisha R&R 2006 Policy for individual family is under competent approval.

CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY OF MCL

MCL has undertaken corporate social responsibility in various spheres. Different peripheral development and community development works have been carried out.

- iii. Providing facilities to district level administration offices.
