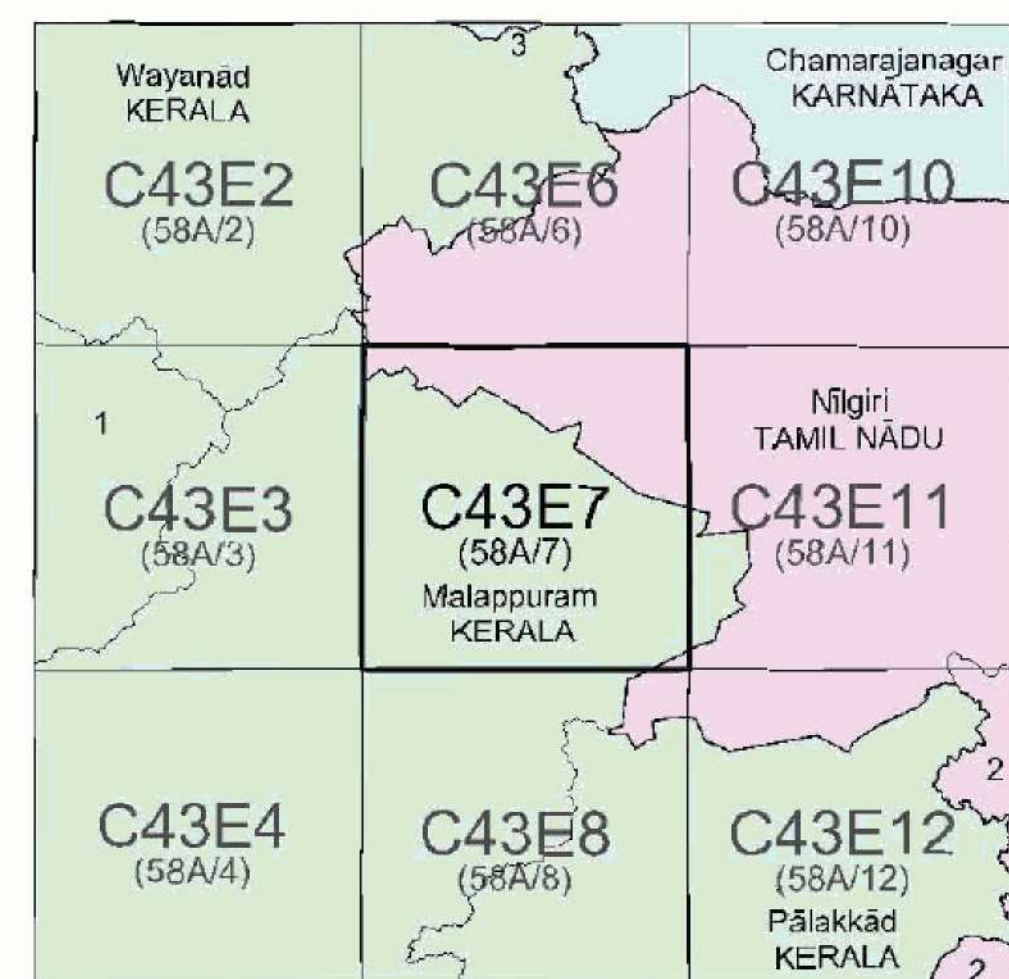

3 Mysore, KARNATAKA

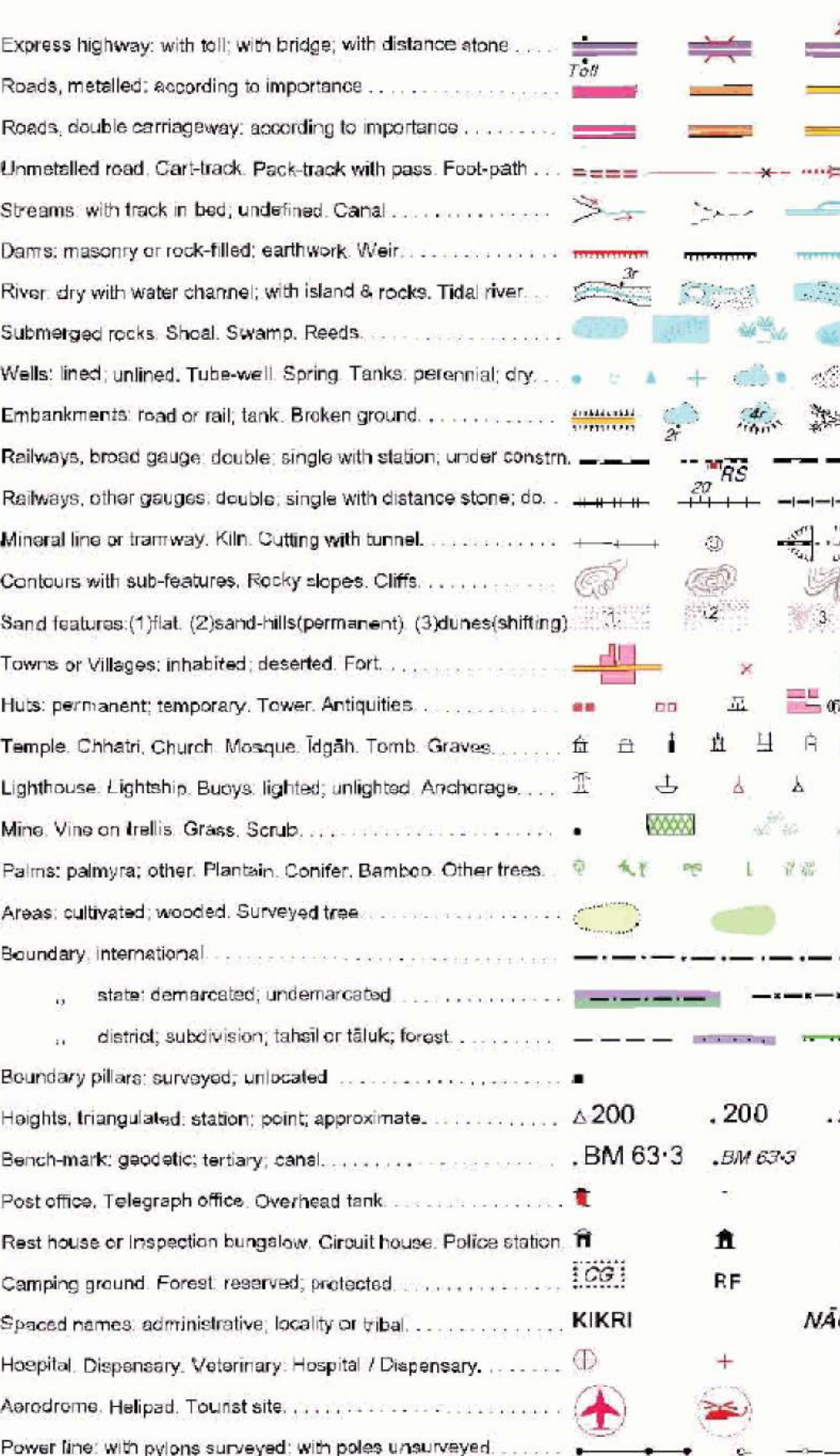

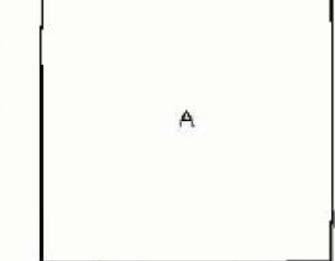

NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A square height, e.g., 5, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Important buildings are shown in black with names.
The kilometre stone numbers along the railway and roads are shown in slant type, e.g., '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'.
Unsettled roads and most of the cart roads are shown in slant type, e.g., '5'.
Double line streams are generally fordable in dry season.
Periodical cultivation (disposal) on rail tracks occurs in the south-west portion of the sheet.
Fences on Karim Puzha and Puzha Puzha only show pedestrian traffic during rainy season.

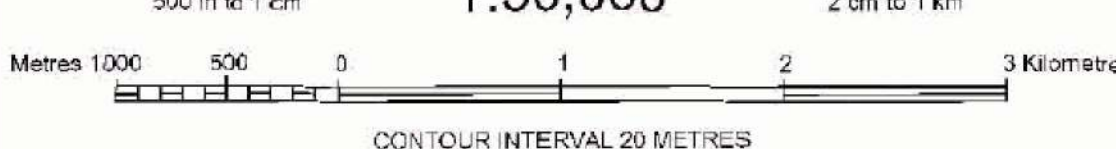
