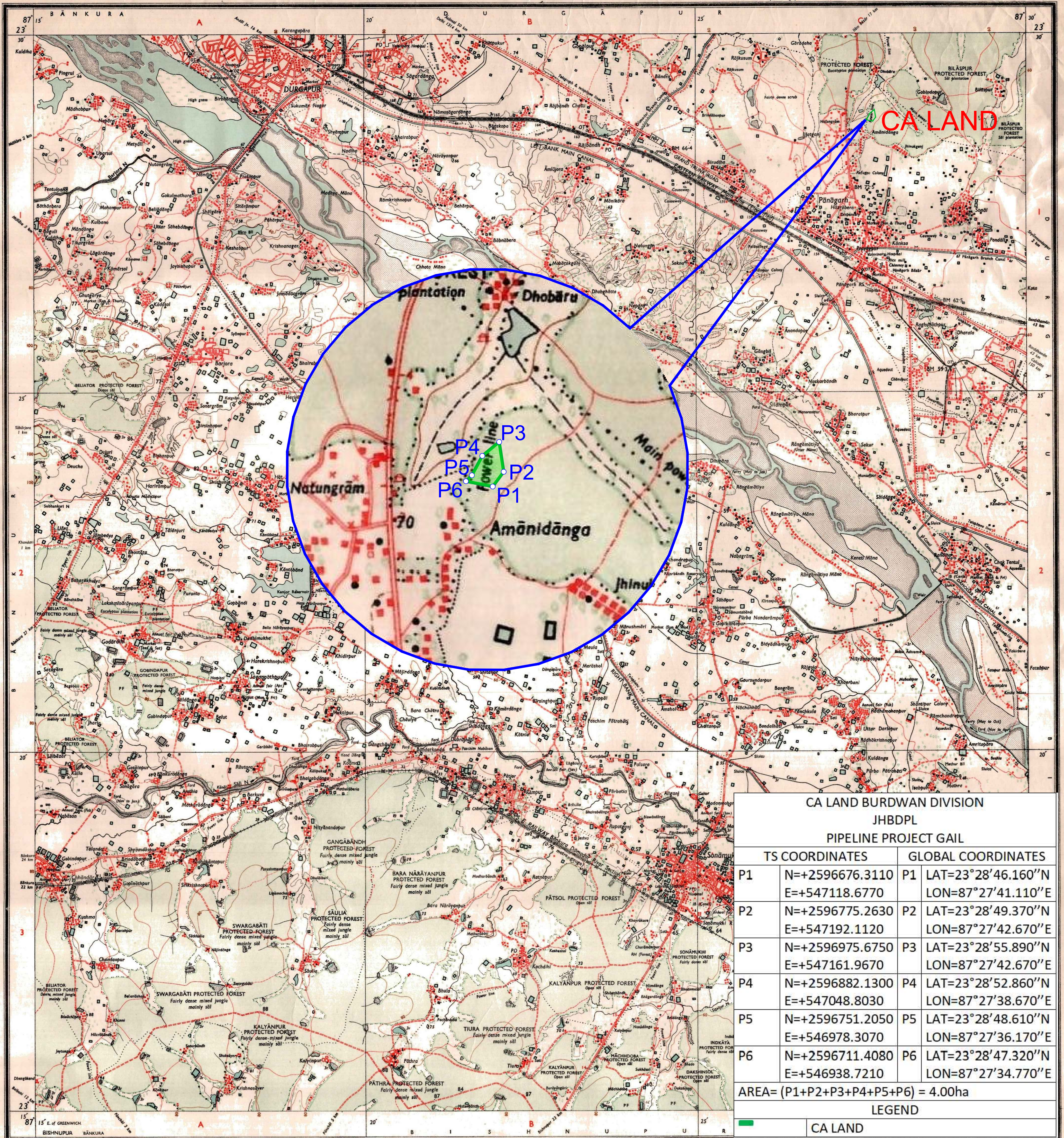

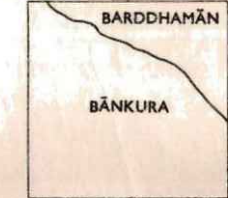

A relative height, e.g. *h*, marked along a canal indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
