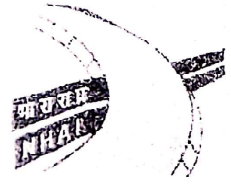

Subject: Issuing FRA Certificate under The Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 for 4 lane up gradation of Indore – Harda Section (Design Km. 29.300/Existing 29.555 to Design Km. 92.971/Existing Ch. 95.000) of NH-47 (Old NH-59A) in the Madhya Pradesh State.

National Highways Authority of India (NHA) has planned for 4 lane up gradation of Indore – Harda Section (Design Km. 29.300/Existing 29.555 to Design Km. 92.971/Existing Ch. 95.000) of NH-47 (Old NH-59A). The proposed 4 lane up-gradation of National Highway involves total 9.287km of length in the forest land and requiring diversion of 40.053 ha forest land in Dewas District. In compliance of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98 FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF&CC issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of right under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF&CC letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF&CC issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that **40.053** hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Project Director, Project Implementation Unit, Indore, Madhya Pradesh, "**Four Laning of Indore Harda Section of NH-59 A (New NH-47) from Design Km. 29.300/Existing Ch.29.555 to Design Km. 92.811/Existing Ch. 95.000**" in Dewas district within jurisdiction of Raghogarh (Tehsil Dewas), Dhantalab & Gadbad (Tehsil Bagli), Khedakhal (Tehsil Bagli), Kalapatha (Tehsil Bagli), Kalwar&Maljipura (Tehsil Kannod) and Kiloda (Tehsil Kannod) Village.
