AWARD UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE LAND ACQUIENTION ACT 2894 FOR THE LAND ACQUIRED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF MAGAZINE NEAR BAGGI END OF P.B. TUNNEL OF PANDON BAGGI END IN VILLAGE KHEURI-II, TEHELL SADAR.

On the request of the Director of Inspection and Control, Beas Project, Sundernagar, the Himachal Pradesh Government issued notification No.4-41/68-Rev. II, dated the 29th November, 1968 under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, in respect of land comprising an area of 179-5-11 bighas, situated in village Kheuri-II, Tehsil Sadar, District Mandi, likely to be acquired for the construction of Magazine near Baggi End of P.B. Tunnel by Beas Sutlej Link Project authorities. Since no objection was received within the stipulated period hence report under section 5A(2) was submitted to the Himachal Pradesh Government for according necessary sanction with regard to proceedings. The Himachal Pradesh Government vide notification of even number dated the 25th October, 1969, under section 6&7 of the said Act directed the Collector, to proceed further in the matter.

Notices under section 9(1) of the Land Acquisition Act 1894 were issued to the interested persons and the enquiry was conducted by the undersigned at Kheuri on 17.7.70 and 22-10-70.

The interested persons pointed out that the rates proposed for compensation are low and in this connection Shri Hem Prabh an interested persons supplied a copy of judgement No. 126 dated 9-4-70 of learned Additional District Judge Mandi, wherein the rates in Kheuri-II, village, have been enhanced by 70%. This fact cannot be accepted, because the rates of five years average at the time of issue of notification under section 4 of the Act, which is given below:-

Therefore the rates approved by the District Collector are accepted as correct.

The affected persons had no min objection about the measurement and apportionment of their land.

Chand R/O Mandi Town represented that they are in possession of khasra No.513 measuring an area of 6-12-5 bighas which have been wrongly entered in the name of the Govt. and have produced a copy of mutation for the year, 1948-49, but the notification under section 4 was issued on 14.12.1968 and the revenue papers (Jamabandi) prepared during that time according to latest Settlement operations revealed that the said land belonging to Himachal Pradesh Government. The plea taken by Sarvshri Sohan Lal etc., therefore, cannot be accepted as correct.

Land comprising khata khatauni No.53/168, khasra Nos.516, 517 and 518 measuring an area of 8-3-10 bighas is recorded in the ownership of Sarvshri Hem Prabh etc. owners, and under the non-occupancy tenancy of Shri Chaiter S/O Sukru in the Jamabandi prepared during the current sattlement but the said non-occupancy tenant has abandoned his non-occupancy tenancy rights with possession in favour of Sarvshri Hem Prabh etc., owners and this change of possession has been given effect from Kharif, 1964, in the khasra-girdawari, a copy of which has been produced by the owners. This fact that the non-occupancy tenant has given up the possession to the owners is further supported by contd.Per

statement recorded by me on the spot on 17.7.1970 during the enquiry in which he has clearly stated that he has abandoned the tenancy rights in favour of the owners with possession. I, therefore, hold that the entire amount of compensation concerning this khatabe paid to Sarvahri Hem Prabh etc., owners.

Sarvshri Gawanu, Nokhoo and Mst. Nagarji during my enquiry stated that all their lands has been proposed to be acquired for Beas Project and they were left a very negligible area say about 4 bighas after acquisition. As these owners reside in village Darbathu which is at a distance of 3 to 4 K.M. and it will not be possible for them to manage cultivation of this land. Moreover, they further stated that it would be uneconomic holding for them and besides this it would be injuriously affected for reasons of adjacent land having been acquired and there will be all sort of disturbances due to the Project work. Their statements have been recorded and there is considerable weight in their statements that the remaining land will certainly suffer from injurious affection and there will be all short of disturbance to these owners due to the activities of the Project in the adjacent of the land, I, therefore, hold that besides injurious affection, this negligible piece of land be acquired by the Project.

and Dagu Ss/O Ramdyal will be injuriously affected as the area which would be left after acquisition in khasra Nos. 549/2 and 550/2 would be an uneconomic holding and will be of little use because about 35 bighas of land belonging to them have already been acquired for the Project. Since this piece of land will be of little use to the owners besides the injurious affection and disturbances which will be constant and imminent there, 2 I, therefore, hold that the Contd.P.-4.

remaining area left be acquired for the reasons stated above, so that there is a natural boundary through a Mallah between village Kheuri-I and Kheuri-II, after this remaining piece of land belonging to aforesaid persons is acquired by the Project.

In khasra No. 470/1, Khata-khatauni No. 43/135, land measuring 0-4-15 bighas has been given in the name of ant. Mansa Wd/O Jai Dev while in column me No. 3 is recorded as owner and Sh. Hem Prabh E/O Sauju E/O Nagar Mandi is also recorded, but his status has not been defined in this column. In column No. 13 of the statement there is a note that during consolidation the possession has not been transferred and therefore, Sh. Hem Prabh is recorded in possession. The note reveals that in Consolidation kh.No.470/1 has gone to the owner ant. Mansa and the name of an. Hem Prabh here appears only due to non-transfer of possession. As a matter of fact Sh. Hem Prabh must have got his share during consolidation in some other khasra numbers and as such Sh. Hem Frabh has now no right in respect of khasra No. 470/1, therefore, the compensation m of this khasra number is given to Sat. Mansha only.

#### HOUSES AND TREES

There are 3 houses and 4 Cowsheds. The assessment of which have been done by the Project authorities based on 1962 Schedule. During the Gourse of scrutiny by the Assistant Angineer,
Land Acquisition, Mandi, it was assessed according to the revised Schedule of 1968, but since the notification under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act was issued on 14.12.1968 when the H.P. Schedule of rates were efforced we see that

Assistant Engineer, Land Acquisition revised the assessment because the Project has supplied the estimates during the year, 1968 when the H.P. P.W.D. Schedule of rates was likely to be revised.

The assessment as supplied by the Project authorities and based on H.P. Schedule rates 1962 are accepted as correct and 15% compulsory acquisition charges over and above the value assessed by the Project is also allowed.

for which the assessment has been done by the Horticulture Development Officer, Mandi, for Rs.1156.50P.
This is accepted and compulsory acquisition charges

15% is allowed over and above this amount.

MODE OF PAYMENT AND APPORTINOMENT OF COMPENSATION:

The land under acquisition is partly with the owner and partly with the non-occupancy tenant. The proportion to the owners and N.O.T. is allowed in ratio of Rs.O.50F. ::Rs.O.50P. each.

There are also non-occupancy tenant 2nd to whom the proportion will be 50% to owner, 25% to N.O.T. Ist and 25% to N.O.T. Dom.

## REHABILITATION GRANT:

whom rehabilitation grant @ Rs.250/- each is allowed. The owners of houses are allowed six months to take the material from themselver the payment of compensation.
