Dear Sir,

In continuation of D.O. letter No's I-45011/14/2010-AD(CD) dated 10th Sep 2010 and 26 Oct 2010 from Union Home Secretary addressed to Chief Secretaries of States / to the Advisor's to Administrators U.T's and several communications on the subject of Revamping of Civil Defence set up in the Country by my office, I wish to draw your attention towards the requirement of identification and allocation of suitable land for the State level Civil Defence Training Institute(CDTI) in your State.

2. Consequent to the report of High Level Committee on revamping of Civil Defence in the Country, Headed by Shri.K.M.Singh, Member NDMA, a Centrally Sponsored Scheme was launched at an initial outlay of Rupees 100 Crores during the current Plan period. Details of the Scheme and procedure for implementation of various components of the Scheme have been communicated to your office by the Office of Director General NDRF & Civil Defence vide letter No VI-14025/1/09-DGCD(CD) Vol I dated 7th Oct 2009 and various D.O. letters to concerned officials from time to time. A Conference of Directors Civil Defence on mid- term appraisal of the Scheme was also conducted in Delhi on 4th Feb 2010 as well as 20th to 27th July 2010, wherein details of implementation of the Scheme and planned allocation of Funds for various components of the Scheme was communicated to all participants.

3. As already communicated to you vide above quoted letters, your State is included in the list of States earmarked for setting up of a **New State level Civil Defence Training Institute**. The complete cost for setting up the institute i.e. Rs 1.46 Crores for infrastructure and Rs 0.46 Crores for equipment and transport is being borne by the Central Govt under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Revamping of Civil Defence Setup in the Country. However, the land (ideally measuring between 5 to 8 Acres), for setting up the Institute is to be provided by the State Govt. The funding can commence only after possession of land has been taken by the Civil Defence Organisation in the State and the Plans for creation of infrastructure have been approved by the State PWD/authorised State Govt agency. In this regard, suggested accommodation & layout plan of Model Civil Defence Training Institute has already been forwarded to you vide letter No. VI-14025/1/09-DGCD(CD) dated 8th July 2009.

4. In spite of 100% funding for New CDTI by the Central Govt., the process of raising the new CDTI in your State has not yet commenced merely for want of allocation of Land by the State Govt. leading to undue delay in commencement of work for creation of infrastructure for the institute. In this regard it may also be noted that the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Revamping of Civil Defence Setup in the Country is to be completed in the current Plan period ending March 2012 and as such initial delay in commencement of processes required for development of infrastructure is likely to lead

to delay in completion of work beyond the Plan period after which no funds can be released to the State under the Scheme. There is thus an inescapable requirement of speedy action for allocation of land for new CDTI to enable the Central Govt to release funds for creation of infrastructure for the CDTI in your State.

5. In this regard I would like to reiterate that the success of the Scheme largely depends on active participation of the State Governments who are the major stake holders of the same, and as such, may I request you to issue necessary instructions to the concerned officials / authorities to initiate immediate measures to identify and allocate Land for raising of new State level Civil Defence Training Institute in the State.

Subject : Land Allotment for Construction of New Civil Defence Training Institute (CTI)

I am directed to refer to this office letter No VI-14025/01/09-DGCD (CD) Vol-III dated 12.05.2010 and No. VI-14025/8/09-DGCD(CD) dated 13.8.2010 and to say that a new CTI is to be constructed in your State as part of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Revamping of Civil Defence Set Up in the Country. While the funds for construction, equipment and transport required for the new CTI, to an extent of Rs 1.92 crore, are being provided by the Central Govt, the land measuring 5-8 acres is to be made available by the State Govt. However, in spite of several discussions during review meetings held at this office, telephonic conversations and reminders given vide the above quoted references, the land for construction of CTI has still not been identified. In this connection Union Home Secretary DO letter No I-45011/ 14/2010-AD(CD)-Pt.III dated 10.09.2010 addressed to the Chief Secretary of your State may also be referred (copy attached). Non availability of land is leading to a delay in commencement of construction and non implementation of an important component of the scheme.

2. You are requested to identify the land for construction of CTI at the earliest and forward the revenue record details of the same to this office. It may please be noted that non availability of land by 31.10.2010 may lead to diversion of funds from your State as the Scheme for Revamping of Civil Defence is to be completed by end of current plan period i.e. March 2012.


