

CERTIFICATE

REGARDING COMPLIANCE OF SCHEDULED TRIBES & OTHER TRADITIONAL FOREST DWELLERS (RECOGNITION OF FOREST RIGHT) ACT, 2006 IN RESPECT OF DIVERSION OF FOREST LAND MEASURING HA. 12.565 HA IN VILAGE BHANJAPALI FOR MINING PURPOSE (INCLUDING SAFETY ZONE) FOR NON FOREST USED & MINING IN VILLAGE BHANJAPALI IRON ORE MINES OF M/S J.N.PATTANAİK UNDER KOIRA TEHSIL.

1. It is certified that the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes & Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act. 2006 has been carried out for the entire Forest area of **12.565** hectors proposed for diversion **for non-forest used and mining purpose of ,Bhanjapali Iron Ore mines of M/S J.N.Pattanaik.** under **Koira** Tehsil. The concerned record of all consultations and meetings held are annexed in shape of Palli Sabha Resolution on **dated 09.04.2015** of village Bhanjapali and enquiry report of Tehsildar,Koira.
2. It is certified that the proposals for such diversion has been placed before the Palli Sabha of forest dwellers under the Chairmanship of the Ward member of village **Bhanjapali** of **Koira G.P** and in presence of more than 50% of members of Palli Sabha and members of Village Forest Committee where the details of the projects and its implication have been explained to them in vernacular/ local language.
3. It is certified that discussions and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was quorum of minimum **50%** of the members of the Palli Sabha present.
- 4 It is certified on the basis of the verification report and Palli Sabha Resolution **dt.9.04.2015** village **Bhanjapali** that no such primitive Tribal groups and pre-agricultural communities were in occupation of the forest land proposed for diversion and whose forest rights are required to be specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1)(e) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006.
- 5 It is certified on the basis of the verification report and Palli Sabha Resolution **dt.09.04.2015** of village **Bhanjapali** that no such facilities managed by Government requiring diversion of Forest land U/s 3(2) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006 exist over the forest land proposed for diversion.

Sir,

With reference to the letter on the subject cited above, I am to submit herewith the detail report in the following paras given below for taking further action at your end.

- 1- The proposal for diversion of 12.565 hectors out of forest land for non forest and mining purpose and safety zone has been placed in the agenda of pallisabha which is convened on 09.04.2015 at 9.00 A.M in the village Bhanjapali. The meeting was presided over by Sri Krushna Chandra Badhei, Ward Member Bhanjapali village, Sarapanch Koira G.P. & all members of Forest Committee and applicants who are eligible under ST & O.T.F.D(FRA) Act 2006 were present in the meeting.
- 2- The details of the project by the way of diversion of forest land for mining purpose and its implication have been thoroughly discussed & explained to them in the local language. That discussion and decision among more than 50% of the members of the PalliSabha in Bhanjapali village has taken place, Thus quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Pallisabha was maintained.
- 3- I have verified the applied area of 12.565 hectors within the mining lease hold area of M/S J.N.Pattanaik, Bhanjapali Iron Ore Mines.
- 4- That, neither any claim has been received nor any patta has been issued under forest Right Act-2006 over applied area of 12.565 hectors under diversion proposal.
- 5- Right of primitive tribal groups and pre-agriculture community have been specially safe guarded as per section 3(i) (e) of Forest Right Act and that no primitive tribal group of pre agricultural communities were found living over the applied area for diversion.
- 6- There is no public amenities/facilities managed by Govt. which are mentioned in clauses (a-m) of section 2 of section 3 over the proposed land for diversion.

Therefore, consent has been given unanimously by the palli sabha on the said diversion proposal in favour of M/S J.N.Pattanaik, Bhanjalai Iron Ore Mines, Bhanjapali.

This is for favour of your kind information and necessary action.

A Palli Sabha Meeting was held in the village Bhanjapali under the Presidentship of Sri Krushna Chandra Badhei, Ward Member, as per letter No. 1091 Dt. 18.08.2014 of Block Development Officer, Koira and Letter No. 151 Dt. 19.03.2015 of Sarapanch Koira Gram Panchayat. In this Palli Sabha the following village forest committee Members and villagers were present and comprehensively discussed on the following subject in their present.

1. In the aforesaid village, the diversion of 12.565 Hectors of forest land for non forest use for the purpose Mining purpose and Safety Zone applied by M/S J.N.Pattanaik, Bhanjapali Iron Ore Mines was comprehensively discussed.
2. In the aforesaid meeting, the purpose and usefulness of said diversion proposal was thoroughly discussed in the meeting in presence of the Members of FRA committee and villagers and they understood details about the matter.
3. Considering the said diversion proposal of the forest land, all rules and regulations to the scheduled Tribe and other Traditional forest dwellers (Recognition of forest right Act. 2006) was elaborately discussed in the meeting. The said proposed diversion proposal of forest land is within the mining lease area of M/S J.N.Pattanaik, Bhanjapali Iron Ore Mines and neither any scheduled Tribe and any traditional forest dwellers have their houses on the said land nor they are using the land for Agricultural purpose or any traditional occupational purpose and forest right act has not been granted to any schedule Tribes or other traditional forest dwellers. The proposed land was not occupied either individual or community basis. Thus it was unanimously decided in the meeting in favour of diversion of 12.565 hectors of forest land by M/S J.N Pattanaik, Bhanjapali Iron Ore Mines for the purpose of non- forest use Mining purpose and Safety Zone by the said company.
