In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's Letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights)Act, 2006 (FRA,for Short)on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 3.793 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of TATA STEEL, Gopalpur (name of user agency)for TATA STEEL PROJECTS & SEZ, GOPALPUR (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Ganjam districts falls within jurisdiction of Badapur village in Konisi Tahasil and Chamakhandi Village in Chatrapur Tahasil.

## It is further certified that:

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 3.793 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee (s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) AND THE District level Committee are enclosed as Annexure I & Annexure II.
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the projects and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
- c) Each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processed under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measure, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. Copies of resolutions made by the Gram Sabha of Badapur and Chamakhandi Villagers are enclosed as annexure-I & annexure-II.
- d) The discussion and decisions of such proposals had taken place only when there was quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabha have given their consent to it.
- f) The rights of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agriculture Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the FRA.
