NOTES

 Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks along canal embankments are usually motorable. Permission to use these is required from the irrigation authorities. Other unmetalled roads in the street are motorable in dry season.
 A relative height, e.g., 20, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
 Ticks, shown on the map, usually contain water from July to January.
