

Justification

The proposed area for the relocation of bagcha village from kuno national park to sheopur(t) is 421 hectares. The proposed relocation encompasses 191 units as of now with a hybrid model consisting of 29 units in option I and 162 units in option II (according to NTCA guidelines). The justification regarding the land requirement and uses are given below-

1. Farm land development:-

- a.** The total units in option II i.e. with 2 hectares of land are 162 as of now. Thus the land required for the same will be **324 hectares**.
- b.** Several approach roads have to be constructed for the farmlands. This will require **20 hectares** of land between farmlands and homestead land.
- c.** In the proposed plan, two ground water recharge structures have been proposed which also require at least **2hectares** of land with catchment area.

2. Community land development :-

The community facilities such as community hall, temple, cremation ground, playground, school building construction and passage, plantation of

grafted saplings near building are being proposed in the plan and it will amounts to at least 20 **hectares** of land.

3. Permanent nallahs are present in proposed area amounting to 5.5 kms in length and the rocky patches along side (atleast 50 mtrs) amounting to **55 hectares**. Thus this area will be utilize for platations under urban forestry and with help of local bodies.
