S.O. 289 WHEREAS by the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Energy, Department of Coal No. S.O. 289 dated the 12th January, 1981, under sub-section (1) of Section 7 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957) and published in Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (11) of the Gazette of India dated the 24th January, 1981, the Central Government gave notice of its intention to acquire land and rights in the locality specified in the Schedule appended to that notification;

AND WHEREAS no objection was made to the acquisition of land and rights in the locality aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS the Central Government after consulting the Government of Maharashtra is satisfied that out of the land and rights described in the said Schedule -

- (a) the lands measuring 37.67 hectares (approximately) or 91.60 acres (approximately) described in Schedule 'A' appended hereto;
- (b) the rights to mine, quarry, bore, dig and search for, win, work and carry away minerals in the lands measuring 57.95 hectares (approximately) or 143.19 acres (approximately) described in Schedule 'B' appended hereto, should be acquired.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (1) of Section 9 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government hereby declares that -

- (a) the lands measuring 37.67 hectares (approximately) or 91.60 acres (approximately) described in the said Schedule 'A'; and
- (b) the rights to mine, quarry, bore, dig and search for, win, work and carry away minerals in the lands measuring 57.95 hectares (approximately) or 143.19 acres (approximately) described in the said Schedule 'B', are hereby acquired.

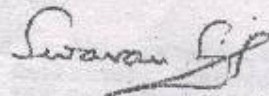
