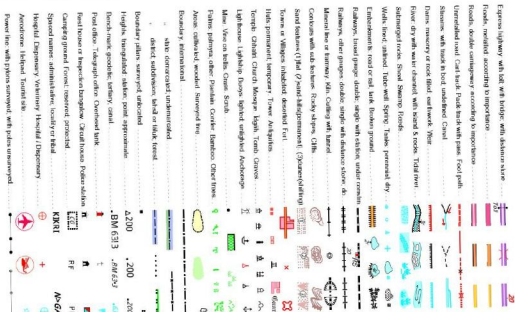

NOTES:

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

Canes are approximately a ribbon height of 2σ , represents the appropriate height in nature, between the top and bottom of a steep slope. Tangles, when dry, in the area usually contain water from July to December. Weeds are numerous throughout the shoot, only the important ones have been noted. Cultivation is periodic and dependent on rainfall. Unimproved lands, if bushland are generally mowed in dry season. This study involves the following: Papyrus and Elephant grass has been surveyed as pointed out by the local residents. Modern Papyrus and Elephant grass has been surveyed as pointed out by the local residents on the ground level and recorded by the 2500m/1000m contour.

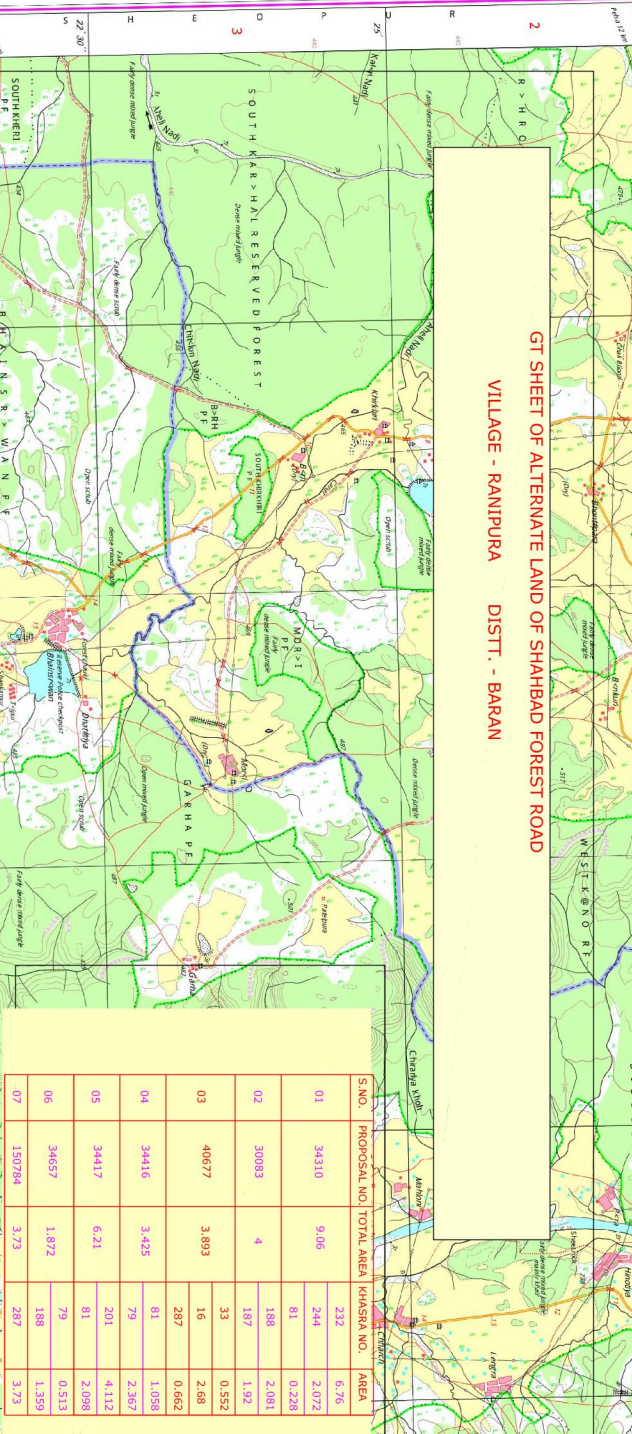

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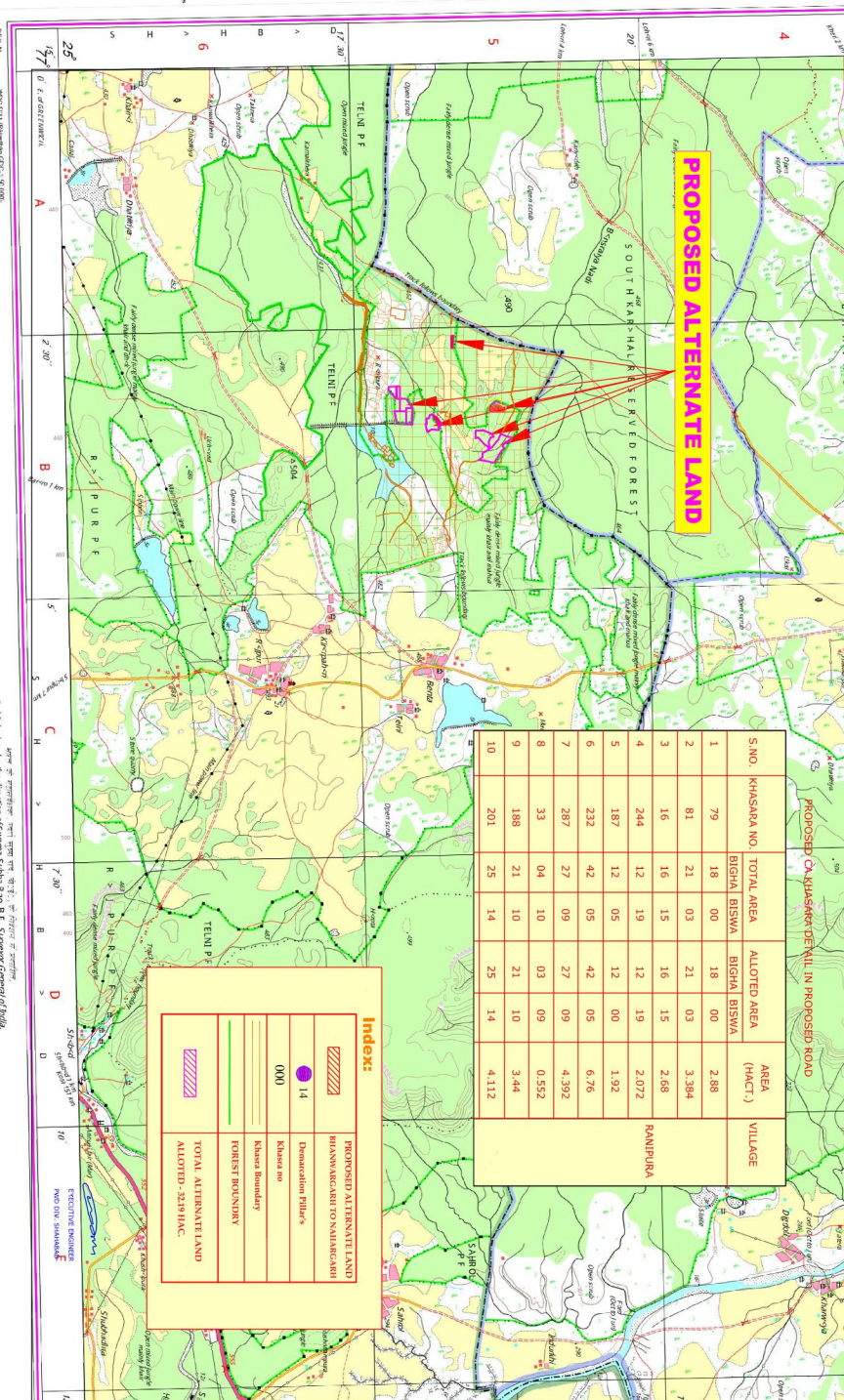
