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# ORDER:

In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad has submitted a proposal under section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of **1.29996 Ha** of forest land for Upgradation and formation of road for BT road from R/F **PWD road to Loddiguda** in Sathnala & Manikgarh RF blocks of Adilabad Division of Adilabad District in favour of District Panchayath Raj Engineer, Adilabad.

2. In the G.O.2<sup>nd</sup> read above, Government have accorded approval **in-principle (Stage.I)** for the above project as per the powers delegated to State Government in the guidelines issued by Government of India, in the letter 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, subject to certain conditions as stipulated therein.

3. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad has furnished the compliance report on the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval accorded by the State Government for the project and requested to accord final approval for this project as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Environment Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi, in the letter 3<sup>rd</sup> read above.

4. After careful examination of the proposal, Government hereby accord final (Stage.II) approval to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad for diversion of 1.29996 Ha of forest land for Upgradation and formation of road for BT road from R/F PWD road to Loddiguda in Sathnala & Manikgarh RF blocks of Adilabad Division of Adilabad District in favour of District Panchayath Raj Engineer, Adilabad, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
- ii. The demarcation of the forest area proposed for diversion shall be carried out by erecting cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of user agency.
- iii. The User Agency shall pay the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, dated:28.3.2008 and 9.5.2008 in IA Nos. 826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and as per the orders issued by Government of Andhra Pradesh vide G.O.Ms.No.124 EFS&T (For.I) Dept., dated:27.7.2010.

- iv. Additional amount of the Net Present value (NPV) of the diverted forest land, if any becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be paid by the user agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- v. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 1.29996 ha in case the land is not taken over by the user agency or the same is not used for the stipulated purpose within a period of two years, then the area shall be taken back by the Forest Department.
- vi. Transfer of forest land to the user agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage-II) approval. The approval accorded in para-3 above shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non- compliance of the above conditions, this approval shall automatically stand revoked.

#### vii. Compensatory afforestation:

- The forest department shall plant and maintain ten times the number of trees felled on the diverted land, subject to a minimum number of 100 plants, to maintain the green cover from the amount to be realized from the user agency, as per the scheme prepared by the forest department, in the planting site indentified for this purpose preferably in the surrounding area.
- viii. User agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum numbers in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- ix. The User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act,1986, if applicable.
- x. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- xi. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- xii. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- xiii. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- xiv. No additional of new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- xv. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- xvi. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest(Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F.No.11-42/2017-FC dt.29.01.2018.

5. The Nodal Officer shall be responsible for obtaining the compliance of all the conditions laid down in the Stage-II (final) approval accorded under the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980.

6. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad shall take further action, accordingly.
