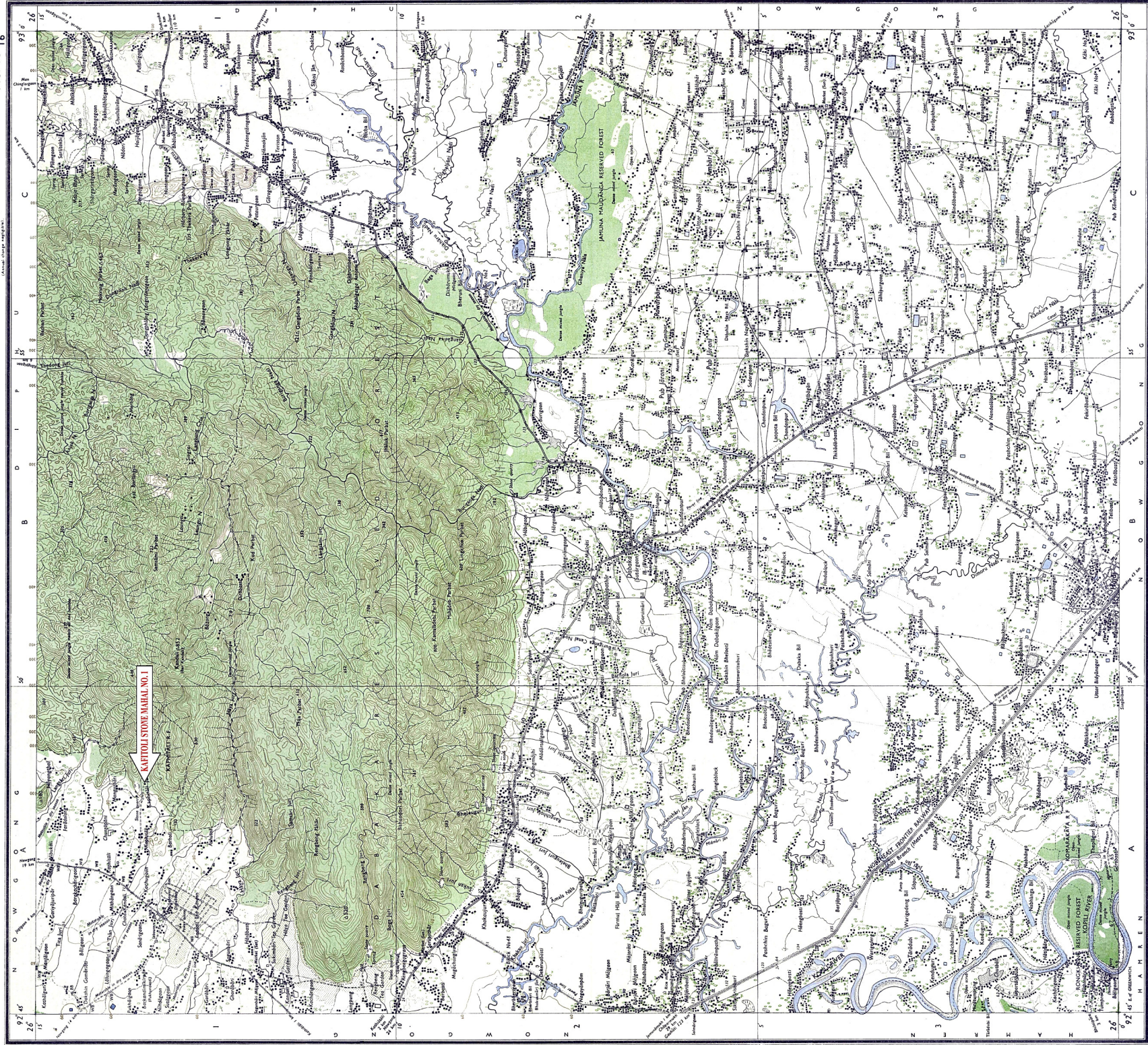




Notes on Symbols: **Boundaries:** International boundaries are shown in dash type, e.g., 1-2, where numbers indicate the distance in miles. **Water:** Shaded areas represent water. **Vegetation:** Shaded areas represent vegetation. **Population:** Shaded areas represent population. **Relief:** Shaded areas represent relief. **Other:** Shaded areas represent other features.

HEIGHTS & CONTOURS IN METRES
CONTOUR INTERVAL: 20 METRES
Contours are approximate. A contour line represents the line of equal elevation. The height of a contour line is indicated by the number on the line. The contour interval is 20 metres. The map shows the Mikir Hills and Nowong District. The map is bordered by coordinates 92° 45' to 93° 0' East and 26° 0' to 26° 15' North.

Scale: 1:50,000
Scale bar: 0 to 2 km, 0 to 2 miles.

Index to Sheet: A grid system is used to locate specific areas on the map. The grid is labeled with letters A through H and numbers 1 through 6.

Legend: A list of symbols and their meanings.
