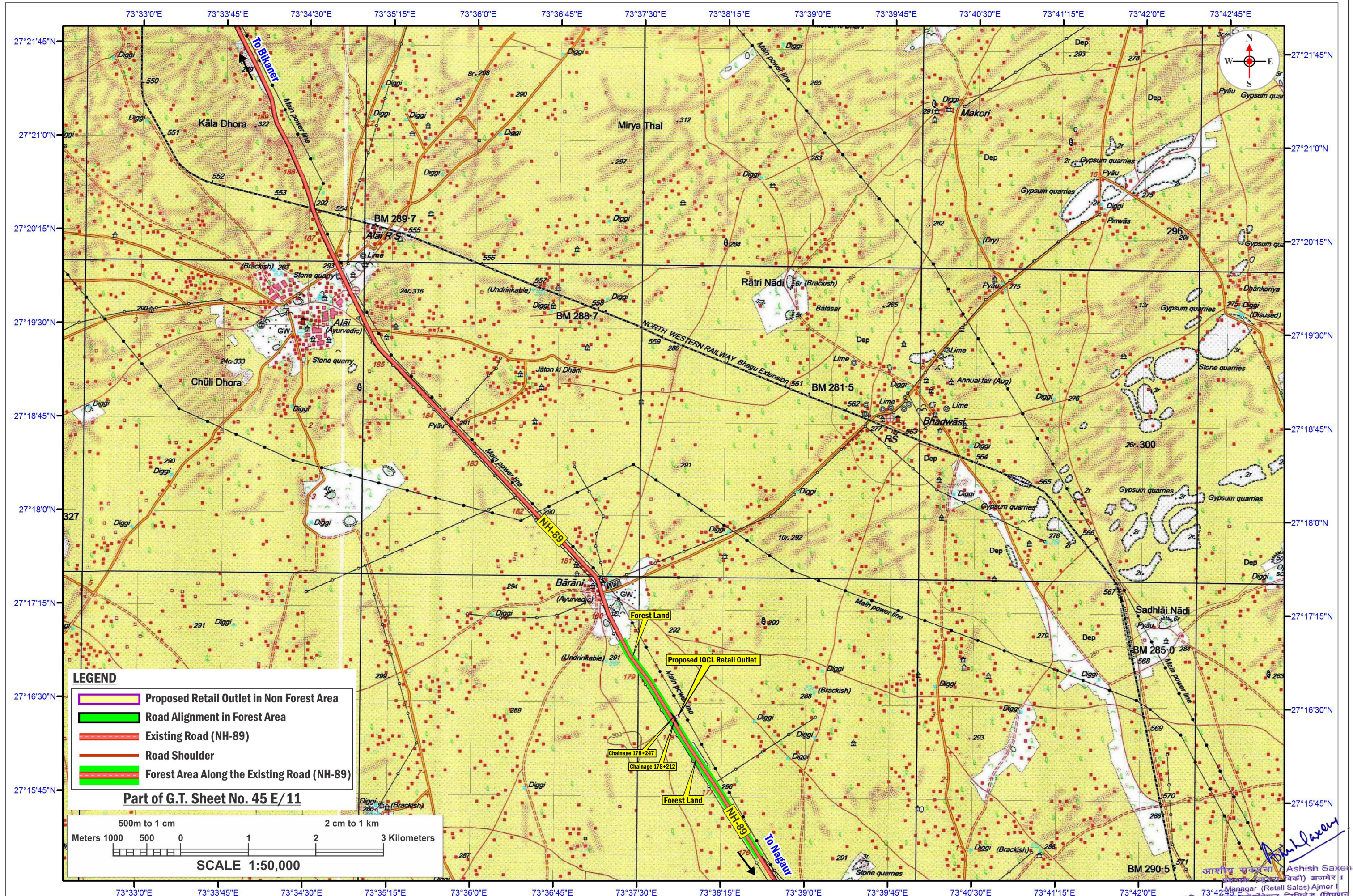

A relative height, e.g., 50', represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
A relative height, e.g., 50' against a well indicates its total depth in metres.
Most of the unlined well symbols indicate covered tanks, called 'Jund', which usually contain surface collection of rainwater.
Tanks, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Limits of cultivation are variable and dependent on rainfall.
Digri is a place where there is arrangement for serving drinking water.
Pydra is a place where there is arrangement for serving drinking water.
