In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9-98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes.

In further modification of the above said letters, MoEF' exempted the requirement of initiation & completion of process for recognition & vesting of Forest rights under the Scheduled tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act 2006 in case of Linear projects vide Government of India's letter No.11-9/98FC(pt.) dated 28/10/2014

- (a) 75.88625 Hectare of Protected Forest (PS) is proposed to be diverted in favors of Road & Building department (State Division) Surendranagar for 4- Laning of Surendranagar Muli Road k.m.126/0 to 147/7 (SH-17) & Muli-Sayla Raod k.m. 0/0 to 10/89 (SH-21) & Sayla-Sudamda-Paliyad Road k.m. 0/0 to 25/6 (SH-21). All section of SH-17 & SH-21 in Surendranagar Dist. Gujarat falls within jurisdiction of Shekpar Villages in Wadhwan Tehsil, Godavari, Kukda, Jasapar, Muli, Sidhsar villages in Muli Tehsil & Sayla, Thoriyali, Sudamada, Noli, Lakhawad, Devgadh villages in Sayla Tehsil.
 - (b) The proposal does not involve recognized right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Preagricultural communities.
- (c) The "Forest Land" to be Diverted is Plantation & notified as "Forest less than 75 years prior to 13th December 2005 & "located in Villages, wherein no recorded population of Schedule tribes is available as per the census of 2001 & 2011.
