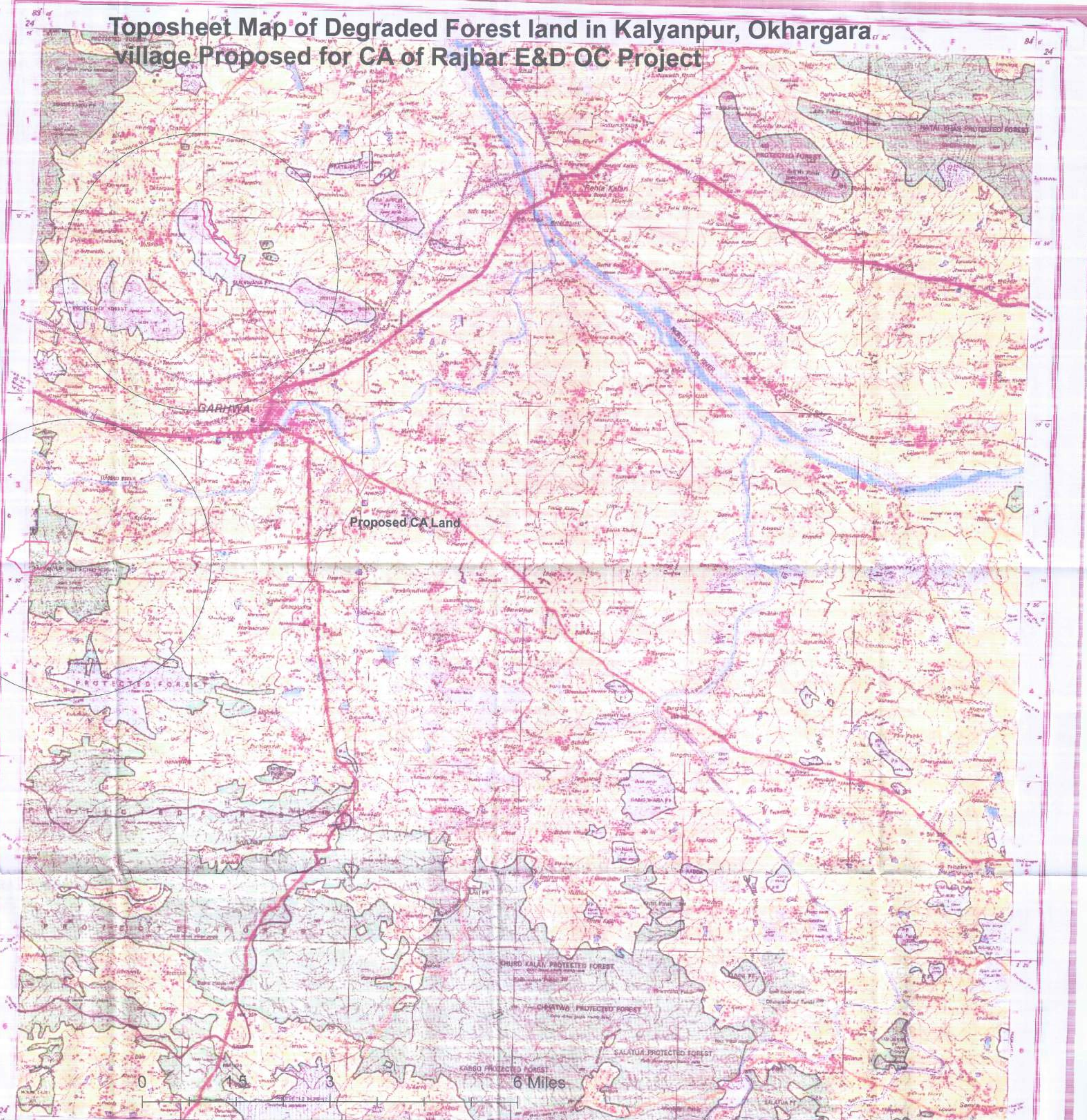

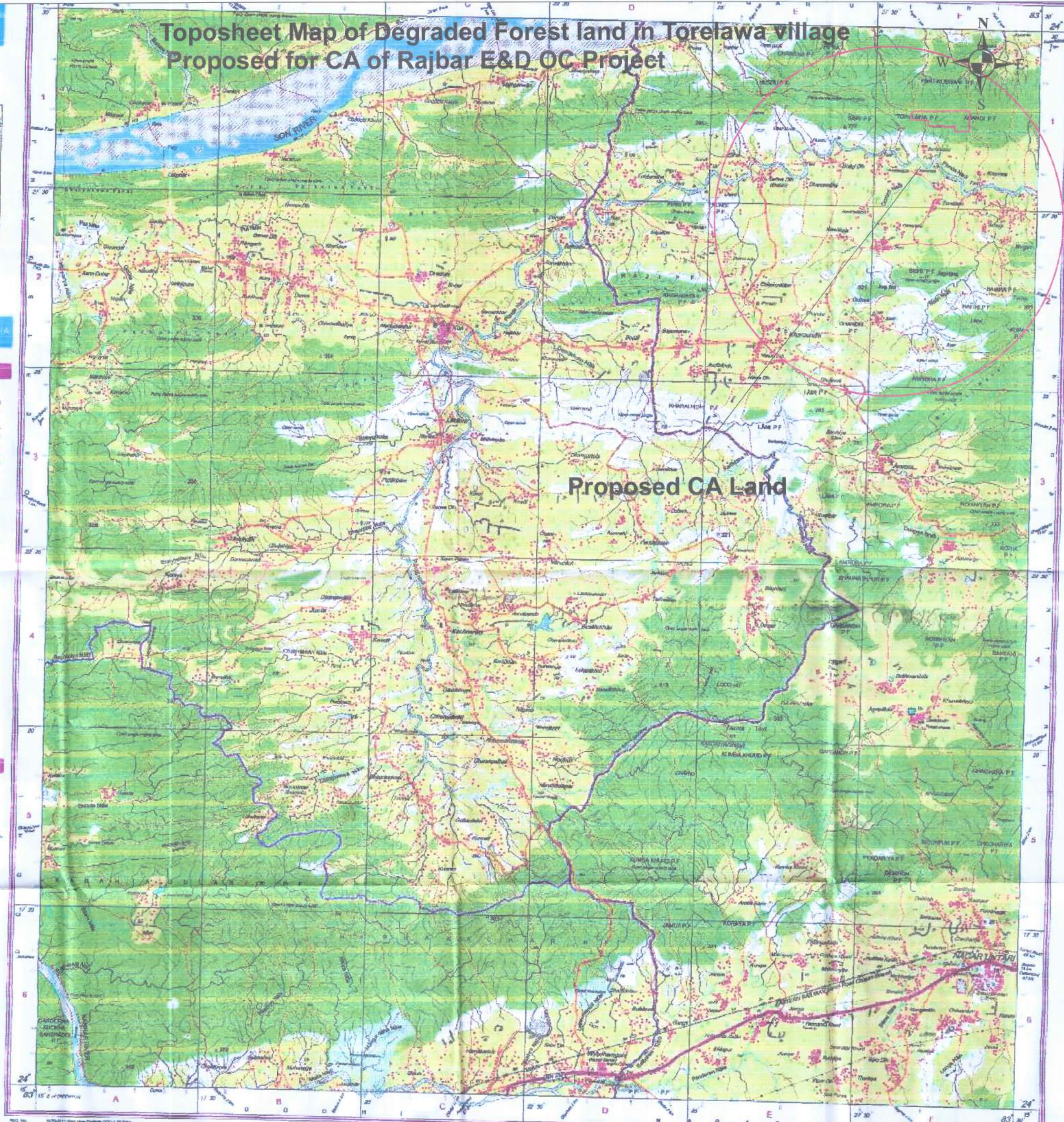

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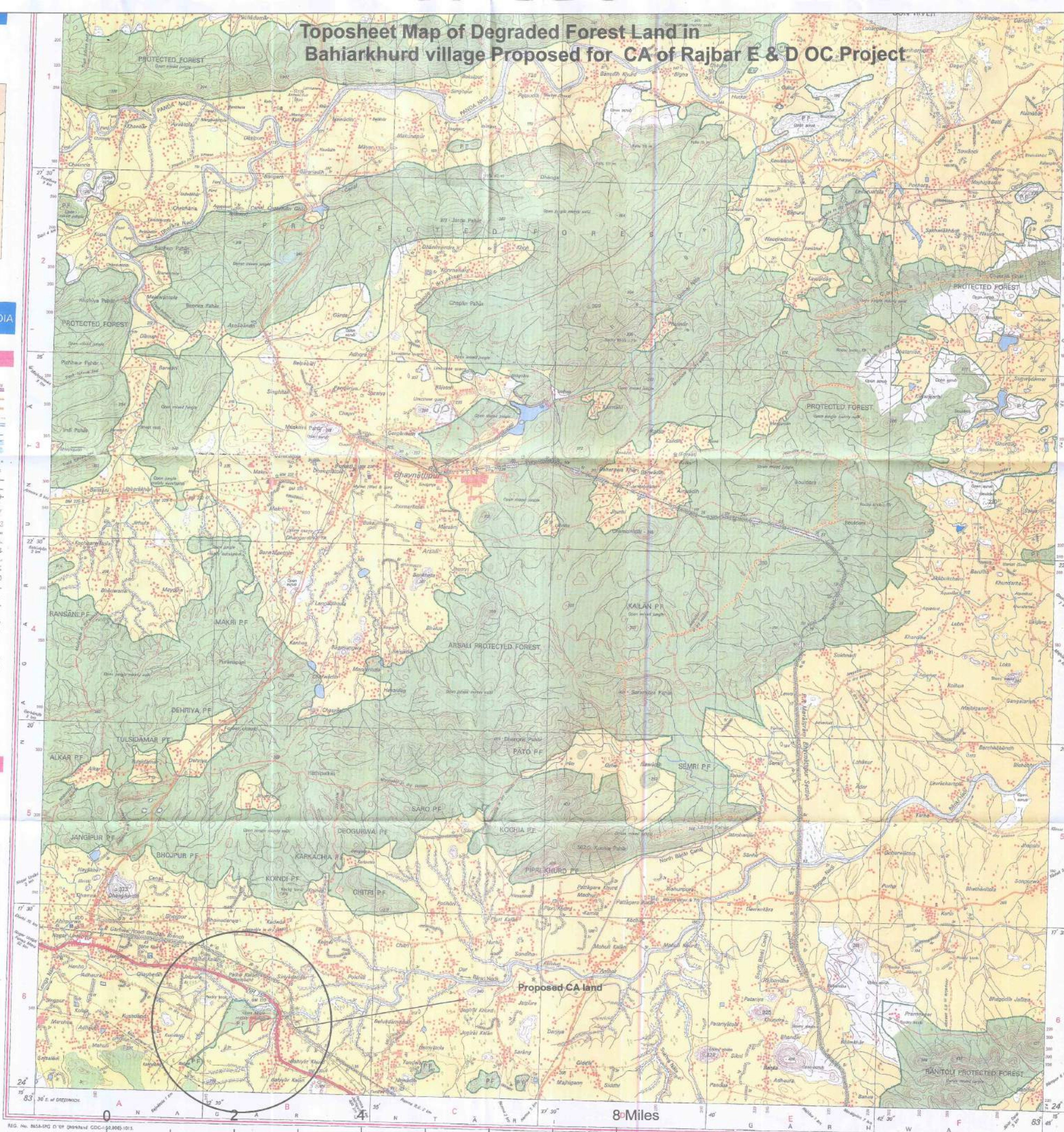
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Toposheet Map of Degraded Forest Land in Bahiarkhurd village Proposed for CA of Rajbar E & D OC Project
