	A relative height, .8r, represents the
	approximate height, in metres, between the
	top and bottom of a steep slope.
	Wooded areas are coloured green. Scattered
	trees and other vegetation are in green, but
	prominent surveyed trees are in black.

The kilometre stone numLers along roads and the railway are shown in slant type, e. g., '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e. g., '5'. All cart-tracks along canals are jeepable in dry season.

A relative height, e.g., or, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country. Wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown. A relative height e.g., 30r, against a well indicates its total depth in metres.
