
TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3 August 2009 where in the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forests Rights) Act, 2006 ("FRA", for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 where in MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, It is certified that **0.8514 hectares** of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Divisional Engineer, H C&M, Tiruvallur Division, Tiruvallur for Upgradation of GNT road to New Erumaivettipalayam road @ Km. 2/350 to 4/100 in New Erumaivettipalayam Reserve Forest of Tiruvallur district falls within jurisdiction of Ponneri Taluk.

It is further certified that:

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire **0.8514 hectares** of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the forest rights committee(s), Gramasabha(s), sub division level committee(s) and district level committees are enclosed as annexure – I to III.
- b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the gramasabhas have given their consent to it.
- c) The proposal to involve recognized rights of primitive tribal groups and pre agricultural communities.
