JUSTIFICATION REPORT.

Justification for construction of road from Gaucharan to Pakha Gaon, Lower Borong under Borong-Phamtam GPU, in South Sikkim. The sanctioned scheme requires forest clearance as it passes through Forest land in Gaucharan.

This project falls in the South district of Sikkim. The road will connect Pakha Gaon, Lower Borong village (which is approximately 19-km from Rabong) in the north-west direction. The proposed road is 2-kms in length. Presently there are no means of vehicular transportation facilities to Pakha Gaon village so as to connect with the District HQ at Namchi & other important towns. The majority of the population are farmers and depend on agriculture. The road on completion, will act as a lifeline of the people of that area for transportation of their agricultural products to the town & help to transport their basic household amenities. It will also help them to reach the District offices, Health care Centres etc. and have easier access to all facilities, which are not available in the village.
