



• Aim & Cost of Benefits of Project


Shingoda Dam Reservoir is built on the Shingoda River near the village of Jamavala in Gir Somnath District of Kodinar taluka and one of the sources of provide irrigation is done in 16 villages and drinking purpose water supply GWSSB Kodinar Group for 48 villages.

The work of Shingoda Dam started from 1973 under supervision and completed 1980, the completion of 38 years has been completed. Approach road of this dam was also constructed with Asphalt cover of 1734mt. Jamavala-dhari Road to Shingoda dam is 1734mt. There are many year and the way to Shingoda dam is very bad condition and pits have fallen. Representing the approach road is very important as it is the only way to leave and go on the dam site. Even on dam, staff officer can start and control on flood cell during monsoon and also work on dam sites work.

There is no issue related to the forestation of land and no case of removal of any forest trees. The proposed work will be repairing of Existing approach road there only one option for reach to Dam site so existing Approach road must be reacquired to repairs of Shingoda dam.
