



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CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Degree highway: with toll, with bridge, with distance stone
- Roads, metalled: according to importance
- Roads, double cartways: according to importance
- Unmetalled road, Cart-track, Path-track with open foot-path
- Stream: with track in bed, unmetalled, Canal
- Canal: masonry or rock-lined, unmetalled, With
- Stream dry with water channel, with bank & rock, Tidal river
- Schismatic rocks, Shoal, Swamps, Reeds
- Wells: hand, tubewell, Tabor, Spring, Taster, perennial, dry
- Embankment: road or rail, tank, Broken ground
- Railways, broad gauge: double, single with station under control
- Railways, other gauges: double, single with station under control
- Metalled line or terrace, Kila, Culture with barrel
- Contours with self-features, Rocky slopes, Cliffs
- Sand features: (Hills) (Sand-Hills) (dunes), (Shallow) (shallow)
- Towns or Villages: inhabited, deserted, Fort
- Hill, permanent, temporary, Tower, Antiquities
- Temples, Chhatra, Mosques, Sighs, Tanks, Ganga, etc.
- Lighthouses, Lightships, Buoys, Sighted unlighted, Aids to navigation
- Mine, Vea on trails, Grass, Scrub
- Palms: palm-tree, other, Plantain, Coconut, Bamboo, Other trees
- Areas: cultivated, wooded, Surveyed tree
- Boundaries: international
- Water demarcation: international
- Water demarcation: local or State, forest
- Fences: surveyed, uncoloured, village, plantation
- Height, triangulation station, point, approximate
- Bench-mark: geodetic, tertiary, canal
- Post office, Telegraph office, Overland tank
- Sanctuary or reservation, Hospital, Church, Mosque, Public building
- Camping ground, Forest, reserved, protected
- Special names: administrative, locality or tribal
- Hospital, Dispensary, Veterinary hospital
- Aerodrome, Helipad, Tourist site
- Power line: with pylons surveyed, with poles uncoloured

NOTES

- Contours are approximate
- Height are in metres and above Indian mean sea level
- Limits of cultivation are variable and dependent on rainfall
- Tanks shown only in this area usually contain water from July to February
- Unmetalled roads and cart tracks in this area are generally available in dry season
- Towns and villages are shown throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown
- A relative height, e.g., 30, represents the approximate height in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope


Projection - UTM Datum - WGS 84
