




OPEN SERIES MAP

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CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway: with toll; with bridge; with distance stone. Roads, metalled: according to importance. Roads, double carriageway: according to importance. Unmetalled road. Cart-track. Pack-track with pass. Foot-path. Dams: masonry or rock-filled, earthwork. Weir. Streams: with track in bed; undefined. Canal. River: dry with water channel; with island & rocks. Tidal river. Submerged rocks. Shoal. Swamp. Reeds. Embankments: road or rail; tanks. Broken ground. Railways, broad gauge: double; single with station; under constn. Railways, other gauges: double; single with distance stone; do. Mineral line or tramway. K.M. Cutting with tunnel. Contours with sub-features. Rocky slopes. Cliffs. Sand features: (dune); (sand-hills permanent); (dunes); (shifting). Towns or Villages: inhabited; deserted. Fort. Huts: permanent; temporary. Tower. Antiquities. Temples, Chhatris, Churches, Mosques, Idgahs, Tombs, Graves. Lighthouse, Lightships, Buoys: lighted; unlighted. Anchorage. Mine: vein on surface. Grass. Scrub. Palms: palmyra; other. Plantain. Coconut. Bamboo. Other trees. Areas: cultivated; wooded. Surveyed trees. Boundary, international: state; demarcated; undemarcated. Boundary pillars: surveyed; unlocated. Heights, triangulated: station; point; approximate. Bench-mark: geodetic; tertiary; casual. Post office. Telegraph office. Overhead tank. Chimney. Rest house or inspection bungalow. Circuit house. Police station. Camping ground. Forest: reserved; protected. Spaced names: administrative; locality or tribal. Hospital. Dispensary. Veterinary: Hospital / Dispensary. Aerodroms. Helipad. Tourist site. Power line: with pylons surveyed; with poles unsurveyed.



NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level. Contours are approximate. A relative height, dr., represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope. Tanks, shown dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to December. Tubs-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown. The milestone numbers along roads, railway and canals are shown in slight type, e.g. '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type e.g. '5'. Unmetalled roads and cart- tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the irrigation authorities. Important buildings are shown in black.
