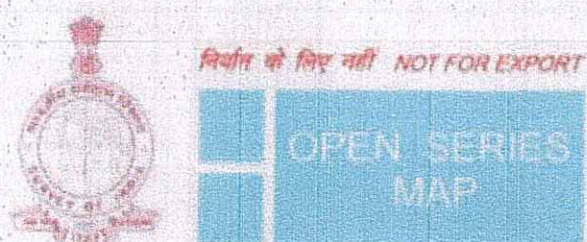


TOPOSHEET MAP OF AREA SELECTED FOR 100 TREEPLANTATION
