In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF) government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3 rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of Evidences for living initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-Forest purposes read with MOERs letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of liner projects, it is certified that 7.332 Hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of National Highway Division Nashik – Peth Section Km 11/600 to Km 65/600 of National Highway No.848 in Nashik District falls within jurisdiction of Golashi Village in Dindori tehsil. And Savalghat,Kautambi,Peth,Kumbale,Inambari,Borvat,Village in peth tehsil

It is further certified that

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 7.332 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as **annexure 1 to 50**
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Per-agricultural communities.
