Point No.5 COST BENEFIT ANALYSIS

The 66KV Line from existing 66kV Ubsal Substation to proposed 66kV Vijaynagar substation through which Agriculture power will feed for 8 hrs in day time to Tribal area around Ubsal Bavaliya, Kanadar, Virpur, Chitrodi, Parvath, Itavadi, Chithoda, Bogapada, Bhagorapada, Chamthan, Badarkhan, Limda, Jaleti, Chikno, Garada, Bhatela, Saroli,,Vijaynagar Ta: Vijaynagar, District: Sabarkantha under Central Gov, "Dinkar Yojna" Scheme

The erection of transmission line work will be carried out through award of works on contract after calling for tender, the work will require extensive engagement of manual labour, and this will generate employment for the public in the vicinity of the line route. Entire district population will be benefited due to the expected employment generated for about 5400 Man days while execution of work and increasing the Agriculture Development and Production due to daytime power supply to agriculture consumers.
