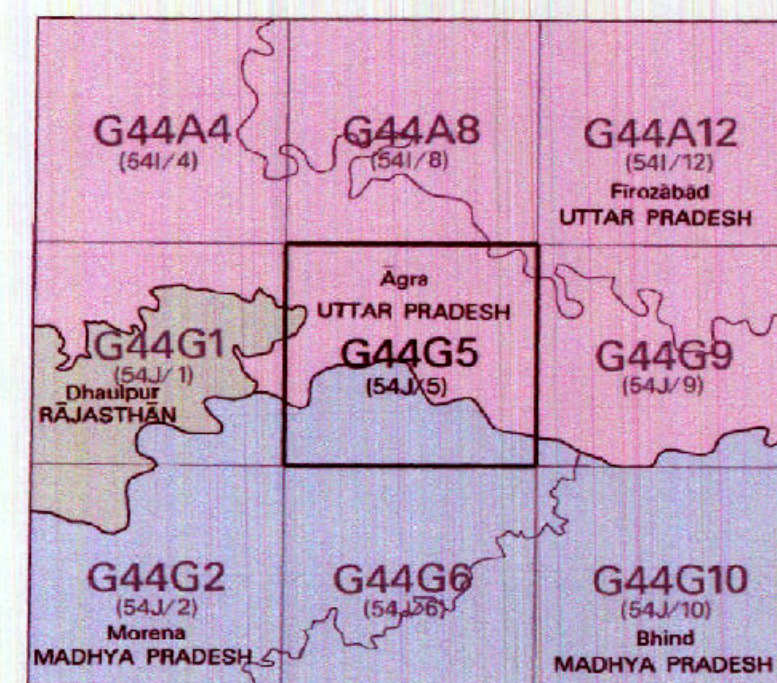

NOTES:-

Highlights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

Contours are approximate.

A relative height, \bar{h}_0 , represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Wells shown dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to December.

Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the shrewt; only the important ones have been shown.

The alluvium stone number along roads and Skarungpur Drain are shown in start type, e.g., 9' unreached mileposts are shown in upright type, e.g., 5'.

Unreached roads and cart-roads, in this shrewt, are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use these roads and to build Reserved Forests is required from the Irrigation and Forest authorities respectively.

The common boundary of the Reserved Forests between Bahr R. and Pindar R. is not demarcated on the ground and has been taken from Forest maps.

The common boundary follows the main deep water channels and will change with the fluctuations of these channels.

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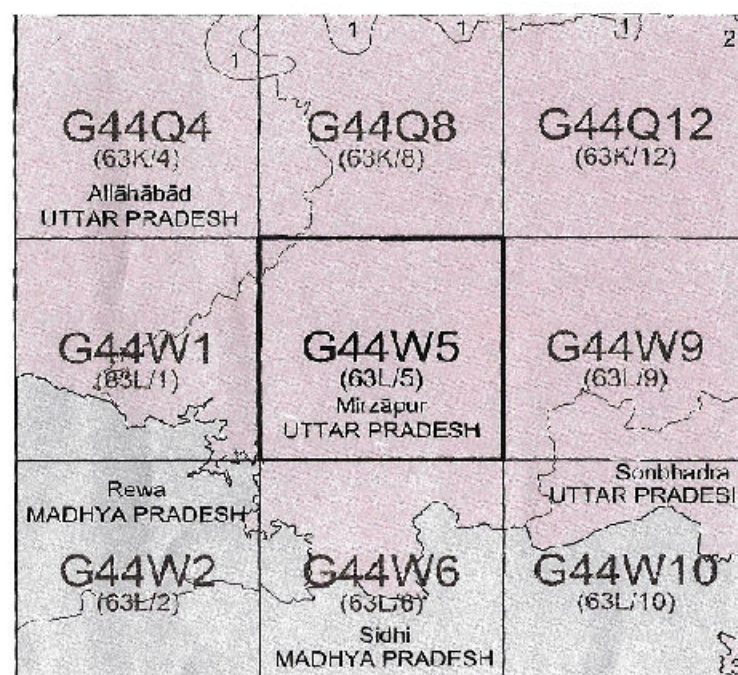

- A relative height, e.g., 10, against a wall, indicates its total depth in metres.
- Postal boundaries and 1:1 scale is the actual boundary, shown below the road in the direction of travel.
- Tariffs, shown dry, in this case usually contain water from July to December.
- Unimproved roads are shown in this case, only the important ones have been shown.
- Cultivation is periodic, and dependent on rainfall.
- Cart-tracks and unimproved roads in this case are generally motorable in dry season.
