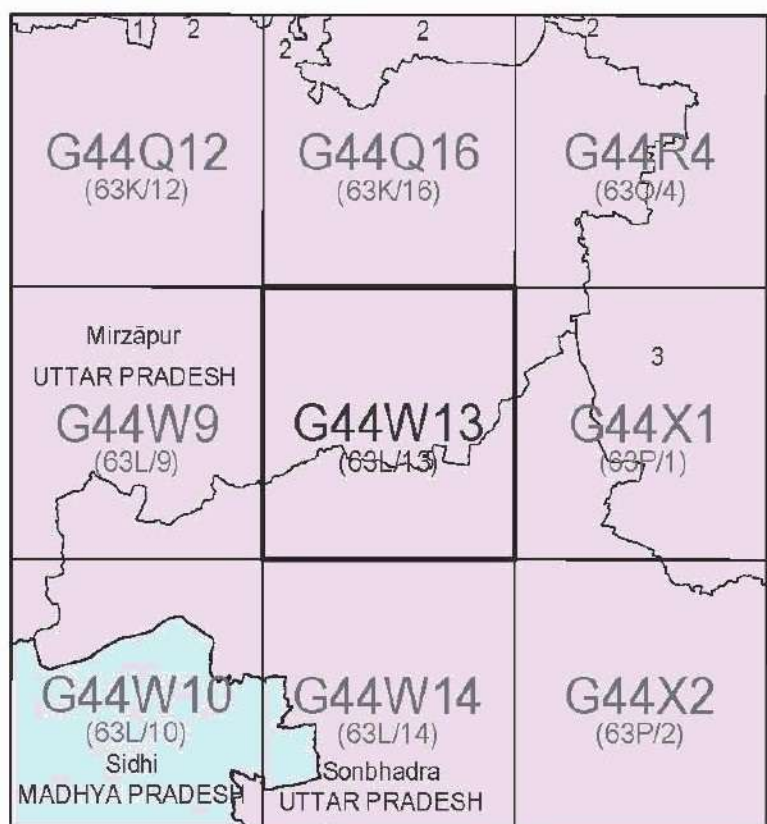

3 Chandauli, UTTAR PRADESH.

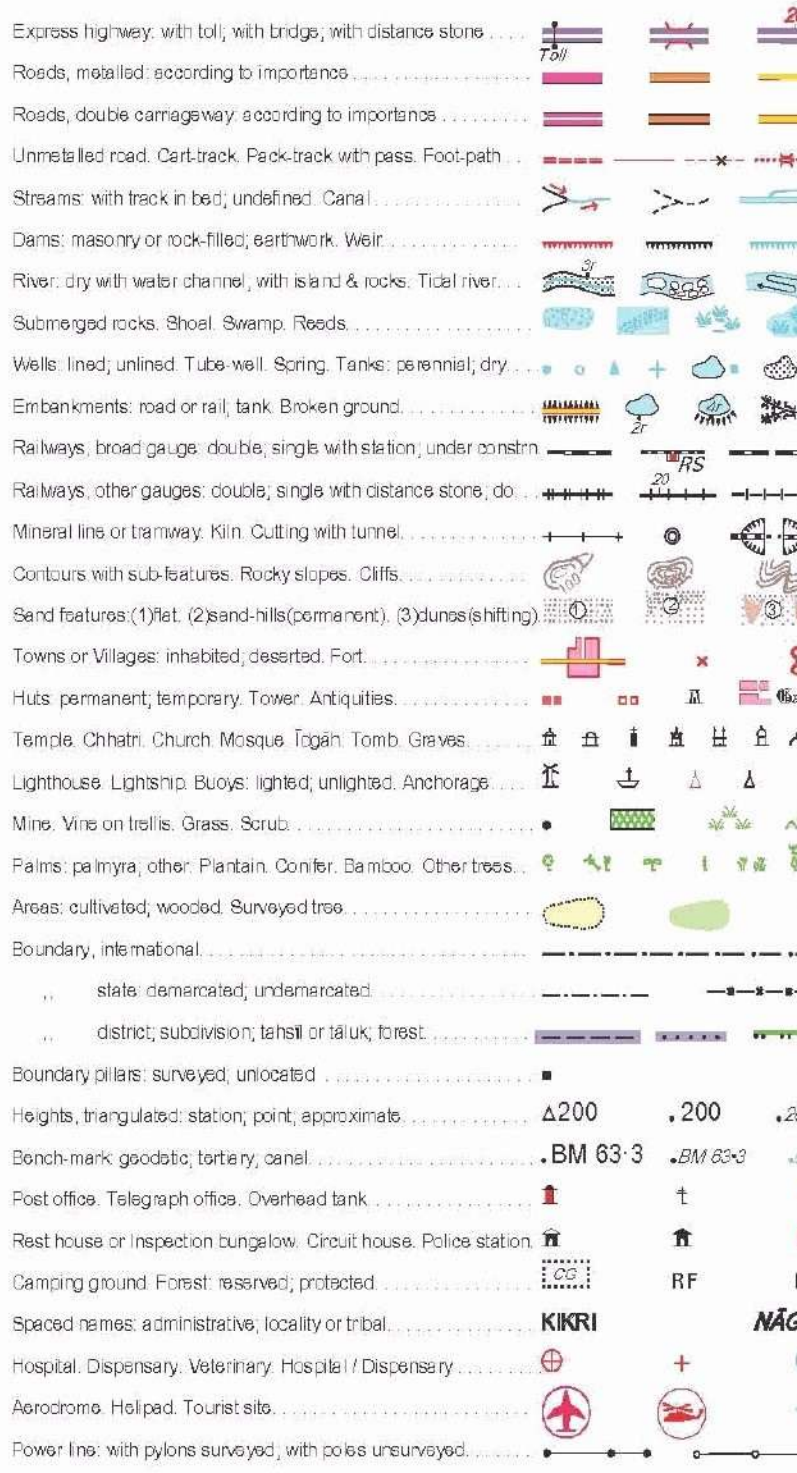

NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
Relative heights, e.g., 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in saint type, e.g., "1" whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., "5".
Wells and tube wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height, e.g., marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Cart tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use those along canals and roads for transport is issued from the Irrigation and Forest authorities, respectively.
Towns shown dry in the area, usually receive water from July to January.
Common boundaries of Reserved Forests have not been shown for want of reliable information.

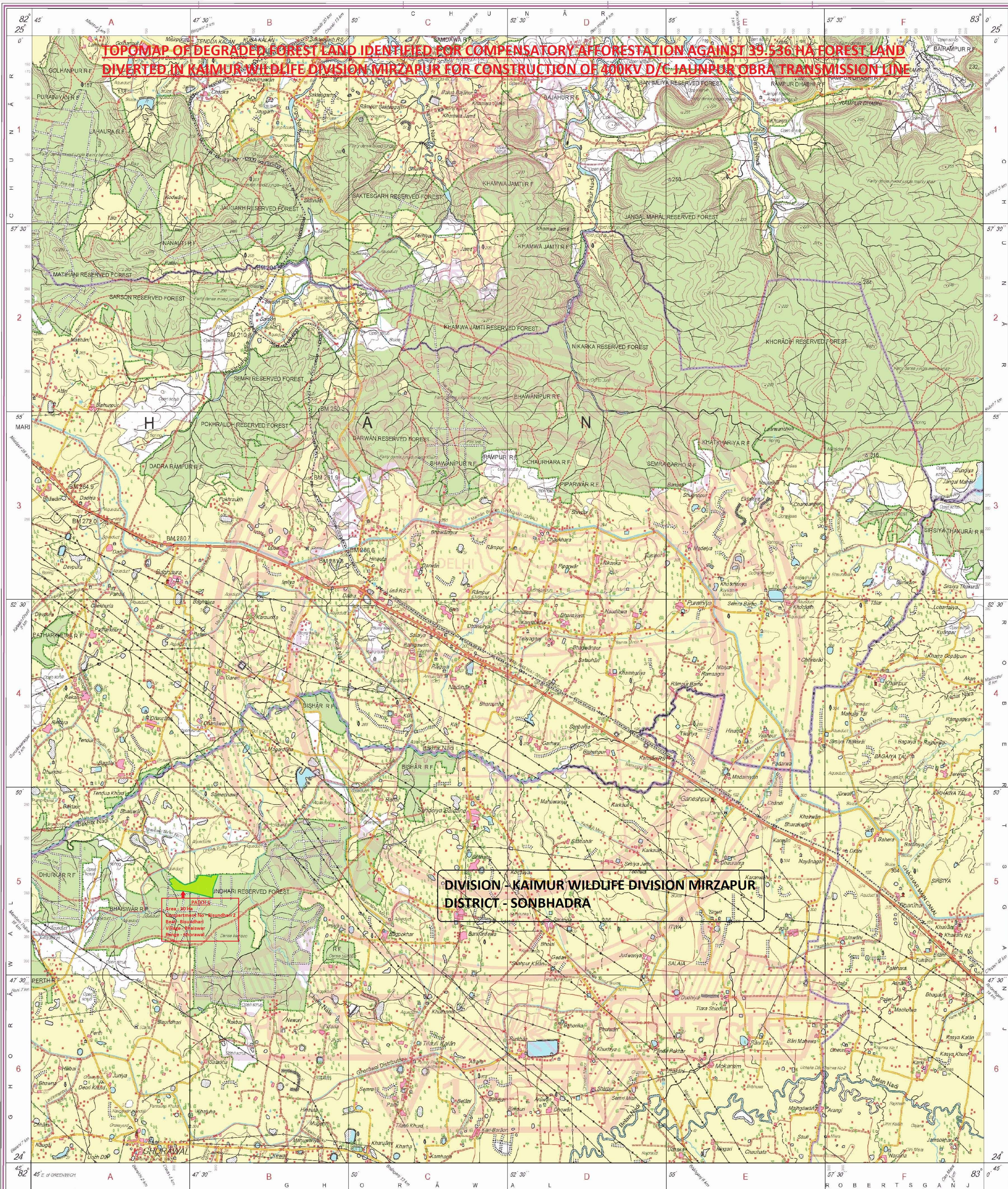
