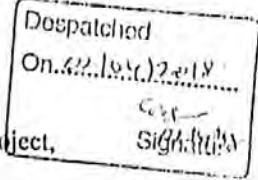

It is to inform that, the Demand notice was accepted by the Addl, PCCF /Nodal officer for FCA, Telangana Hyderabad vide reference 7th cited above.

The Superintending Engineer, Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project, (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal is requested to go through the references carefully and fulfill the conditions stipulated in the reference 1st cited, the conditions are as follows.

Further, the User Agency is requested to comply with the following accordance with the Government of India instructions issued vide F.No.7-23/2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide PCCF's Rc.No.45921/2001-F4, Dt.23.08.2013 and publish the orders at the cost of the project proponent.

1. Publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and the other in English language, so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purpose.
2. The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Head of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same in 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.

Further, the Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal is requested to furnish the copies of Paper clippings about the publishing of forest Clearance etc., as instructed by the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests TS Hyderabad vide reference 1st cited the said reference along with its enclosures are enclosed for ready reference.

The user agency is requested to upload the demand notice at forestsclearance.nic.in and generate challan through the Ministry's Website, after approval by Nodal officer and then deposit the above amounts against the challan generated. Step-by-step process for depositing the funds is available at forestsclearance.nic.in. and report compliance.

Further it is also informed that, this in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after 5 years.

Therefore It is requested to refer all the references in connection with this case at utmost care and furnish the required information as called in this case urgently for taking further course of action.

Hence, the Superintending Engineer, Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project, (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal is requested to furnish the compliance report along with NPV and other payments particulars / copies of paper clippings about the publishing of forest clearance etc., and submit the condition wise compliance report to this office for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval from the competent authority.

The transfer of forestland to User agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval (or) working permission whichever is earlier.

Early action is requested.
