It is to inform that, the Government has approved (Stage-I) for Diversion of forest land to an extent of diversion of 29.216 Ha of forest land in erstwhile Adilabad District and presently Asifabad (20.484 Ha), Utnoor (FDPT) (7.031 Ha) and **Adilabad (1.701 Ha)** forest divisions of Adilabad and Komarambheem Districts - for laying of Pipelines and construction of Structures in **Segment-22/17 (Powerguda)** for providing safe drinking water to Adilabad District, passing through Reserve Forest areas of in Adilabad District, duly stipulating certain conditions to be complied vide reference 1st cited and communicated by the Pri Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 2nd cited.

Further it is informed that, vide reference 5th cited, instructions have been issued that, to issue the demand to the user agency and mention correct account number for depositing the amount.





The user agency is requested to comply with the following in accordance with the GoI instructions issued vide F. No. 7-23/2012-FC, dt 24.07.2013 communicated vide P.C.C.F, A.P, Hyderabad Rc.No. 45921/2001-F4, dt. 23.08.2013, at the cost of the Project proponent.

- 1) Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe guard imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.
- 2) The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

CAMPA. The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the CA and other levies only by generating challan through the Ministry's website. Further the user agency has to deposit the amount for certain items under the PD Account of Forest Divisional Officer, Adilabad as mentioned above.

- (xi) The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas.
- (xii) Tree felling in the proposed forest area shall be carried out wherever necessary, with prior permission of the Divisional Forest Officer concerned.
- (xiii) The State Forest Department shall carryout translocation of the trees, wherever feasible at the cost of user agency.
- (xiv) Wherever necessary, user agency shall provide free supply of water for forest nurseries and field staff quarters and range offices, besides providing outlets with small troughs during summer for wild animals in forest areas.
- (xv) The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
- (xvi) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- (xvii) The user agency shall use existing paths and roads for laying of pipeline and no new paths / roads are to be formed.
- (xviii) Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora & fauna.
- (xix) The total forest area utilized for the Project shall not exceed **1.701 Ha of Adilabad division** and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal.
- (xx) The user agency should make provisions for supply of water to wildlife at designated places / along the route passing through forest areas, in consultation with Telangana Forest Department. Such provision should be made at intervals of 2 Km each. The Chief Wildlife Warden is advised to develop a master plan to use the proposed pipelines for Supply of water to the Wildlife. Precautions have to be taken to avoid concentration of livestock at the water point.
- (xxi) The State Government and the user agency shall implement mitigation measures and other conditions as recommended by the standing Committee of NBWL vide Ministry's letter No. 6-69/2017/WL, dated 02.06.2017 at the project cost.

(xxii) The progress of the Compensatory Afforestation as mentioned by the DFO, Adilabad Division in Sl No. 12(v) (a) & (b) of part II i.e. 164 Ha of forest land and 53.38 Ha of Non forest land, DFO, Asifabad Division in Sl No. 12(v) (a) & (b) of part II i.e. 94.510 Ha of forest land and 196.210 Ha of Non forest land and DFO, Utnoor (FDPT) Division in Sl No. 12(v) (a) & (b) of part II i.e. 164 Ha of forest land and 53.38 Ha of Non forest land shall be monitored by the Circle Head and a copy of such monitoring report shall be forwarded to the regional office to upload the same in the web portal.

~~(xxiii) User agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.~~

(xxiv) The user agency shall submit annual self compliance report to the Regional Office, Chennai.

(xxv) Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. PCCF(Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.

(xxvi) In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.

After receipt of the compliance report on the above mentioned conditions, the proposals will be considered for final approval. Transfer of forest land to the User agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.


