
WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98/FC(pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.9984 Hectares of forest land of Peechi Wild Life Division, comprised in Survey No.1534/5 (0.1127 Ha), No.1534/6 (0.6214Ha), No.1534/7 (0.0895 Ha), No.3346/3 (0.0896 Ha), Survey No.3323/p (0.0436 Ha), Survey No.1623/4 - (0.0360 Ha) Peechi Village and Survey No.1/2p (0.0056Ha) in Pananchery Village and 0.3826Ha of forest land in Thrissur Forest Division comprised in Survey No.3385/1 (0.2418Ha) and Survey No.1077/2 (0.1408Ha) of Peechi Village of Thrissur Taluk in Thrissur District proposed to be diverted in favour of National Highway Authority of India (Name of User Agency) for widening of National Highway (Purpose for diversion of forest land) in Thrissur District falls within jurisdiction of Peechi and Pananchery Villages (in Thrissur Tehsil).
