In Compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF), Government of India's letter no. 11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MOEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects it is certified that 35.00 Acars (14.17 hectares) of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of M/s Ramchandra Mehta **Captain Anand Aparna Devi (name of user agency)** for Karma Stone Mines (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Hazaribagh district falls within jurisdiction of Karma village(s) in Chouparan tehsils.

In compliance of the ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No-11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 Wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for Short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that **35.00acer (14.17 hectare.)** of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **M/s Ram Chander Mehta Captain Anand Aparna Devi**, for Karma Stone Manning Project (Propose for diversion of forest land) in **Dist- Hazaribagh**. district falls within jurisdiction of Vill- **Karma, in Choupran** tehsils.

- c) The each concerned gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram Sabha of **Karma village** is enclosed as aneexure
- d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken pace only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabha have given their consent to it;
- f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the FRA.
