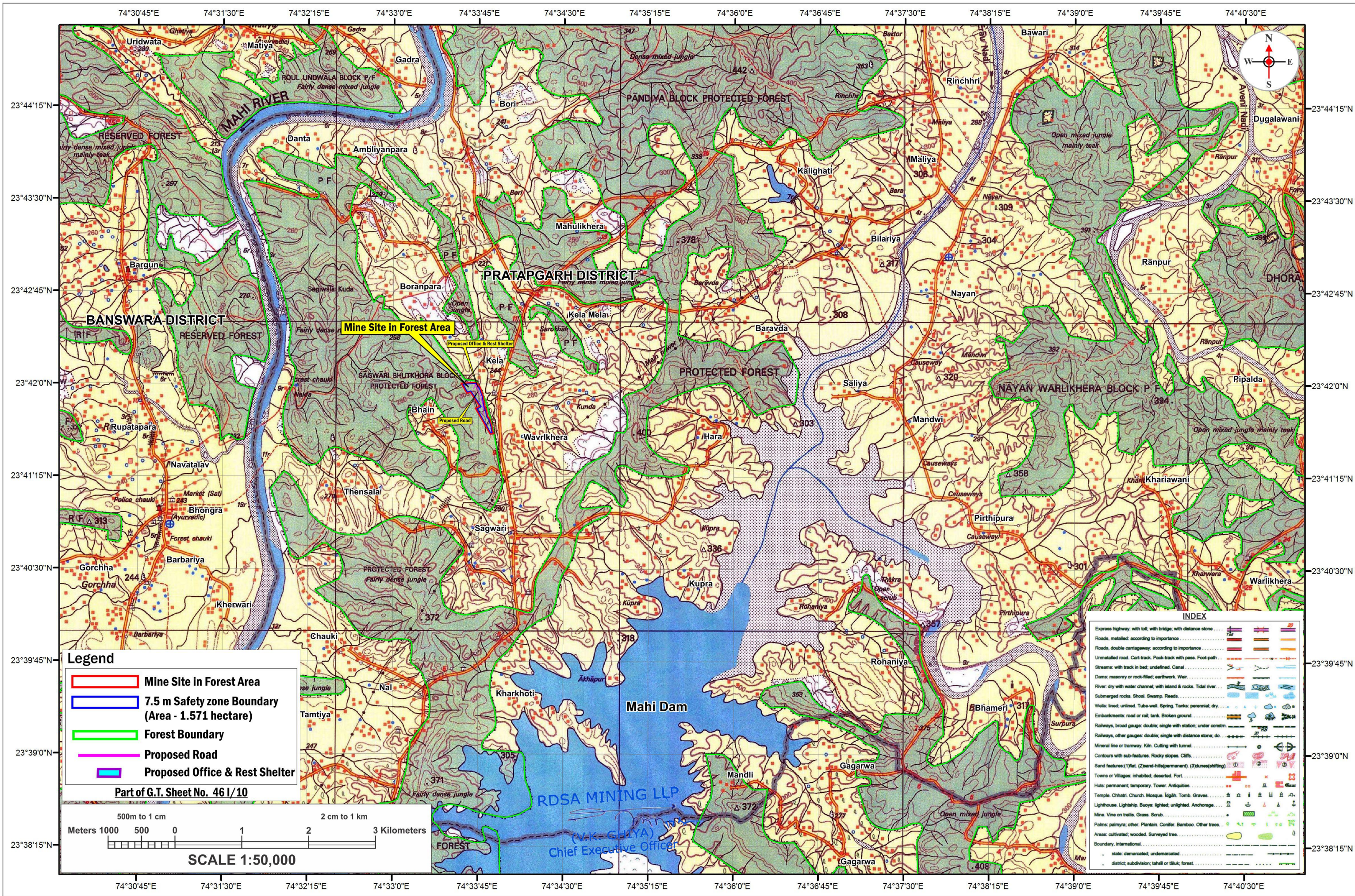


MAP SHOWING GEO-REFERENCED SURVEY OF INDIA TOPOSHEET WITH MINE SITE AND FOREST BOUNDARY

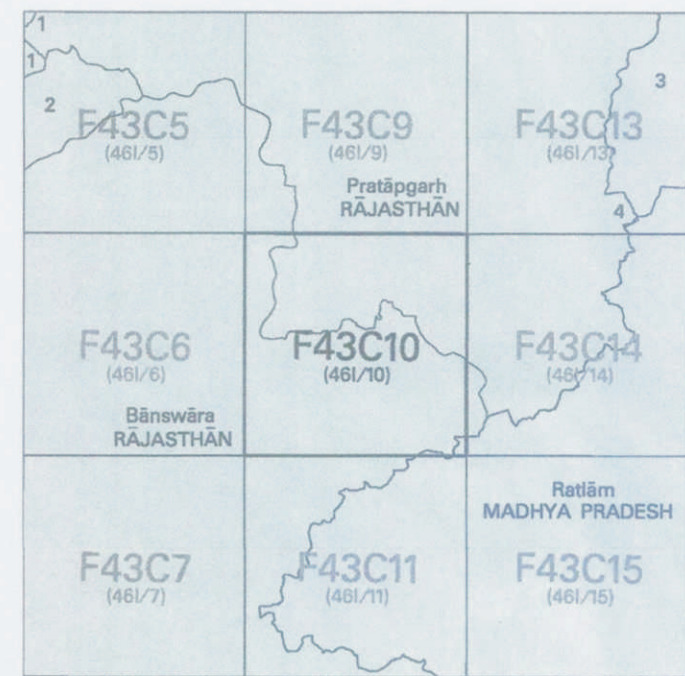

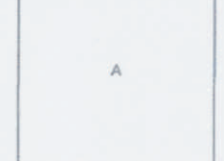

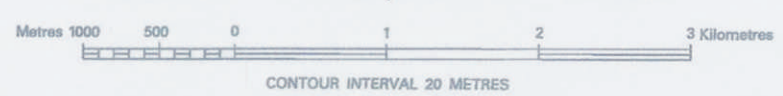
