INDIAN FOREST ACT, 1927.

No. FLD-28/2017/C.R. 803/E-3. — In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927), the Government of Maharashtra is pleased with reference to Divisional Commissioner, Aurangabad Notification No. 2008/RB-Desk-2/LND-2/CR1/k/w324, published in Gazette dated 28th March 2013 to declare the land in the Tuljapur Taluka of Osmanabad District, specified in the schedule hereto annexed, to be Reserved Forest from date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.

hereto; and

(c) appoints the Assistant Collector or
Deputy Collector incharge of the Aurangabad taluka,
to be the Forest Settlement Officer to inquire into and
determine the existence, nature and extent of any rights
alleged to exist in favour of any person in or over any
land comprised within the limits of the reserved forest,
or in or over any forest produce, and to deal with the
same as provided in Chapter II of the said act.

(d) appoints the Collector Osmanabad to
hear appeals from any orders passed by the Forest
Settlement Officer under sections 11, 12, 15 and 16 of
the said Act.
