JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT IN FOREST AREA

Proposed Transmission Line Alignment for "Construction of 220 KV D/C AJMER-BHERUNDA Transmission Line from 400KV GSS Ajmer to 220KV GSS Bherunda (Rajasthan)" has been examined for Social, Technical and Economical consideration and possible efforts were made to avoid the forest land by RVPN but the proposed route of transmission line is not possible without the involvement of forest land. Transmission line survey has been done by RVPN and found that there is no alternative route to lay the transmission line. Further the transmission line passes through bare minimum forest comparing with other possible routes examined. Alternative route also uploaded in the said proposal for information. It is further stated that the area of forest land involved for Proposed transmission line for "Construction of 220 KV D/C AJMER-BHERUNDA Transmission Line from 400KV GSS Ajmer to 220KV GSS Bherunda (Rajasthan)" is technically correct with respect to design of transmission line. Further it is also involving bare minimum forest land and approved by RVPN (Govt. of Rajasthan).
