NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

Contours are approximate.

A relative height, e.g. 100, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.

Water features: are shown in blue where they generally contain water.

This kilometre stone numbers along roads are shown in slant type, e.g. 3, whereas mile numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. 3.

Personal sightings in this sheet are forborne from November to June at the places indicated as such.

All cart tracks along canals are motorable in dry season whereas other cart tracks, against which there is no descriptive remark, are generally passable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.

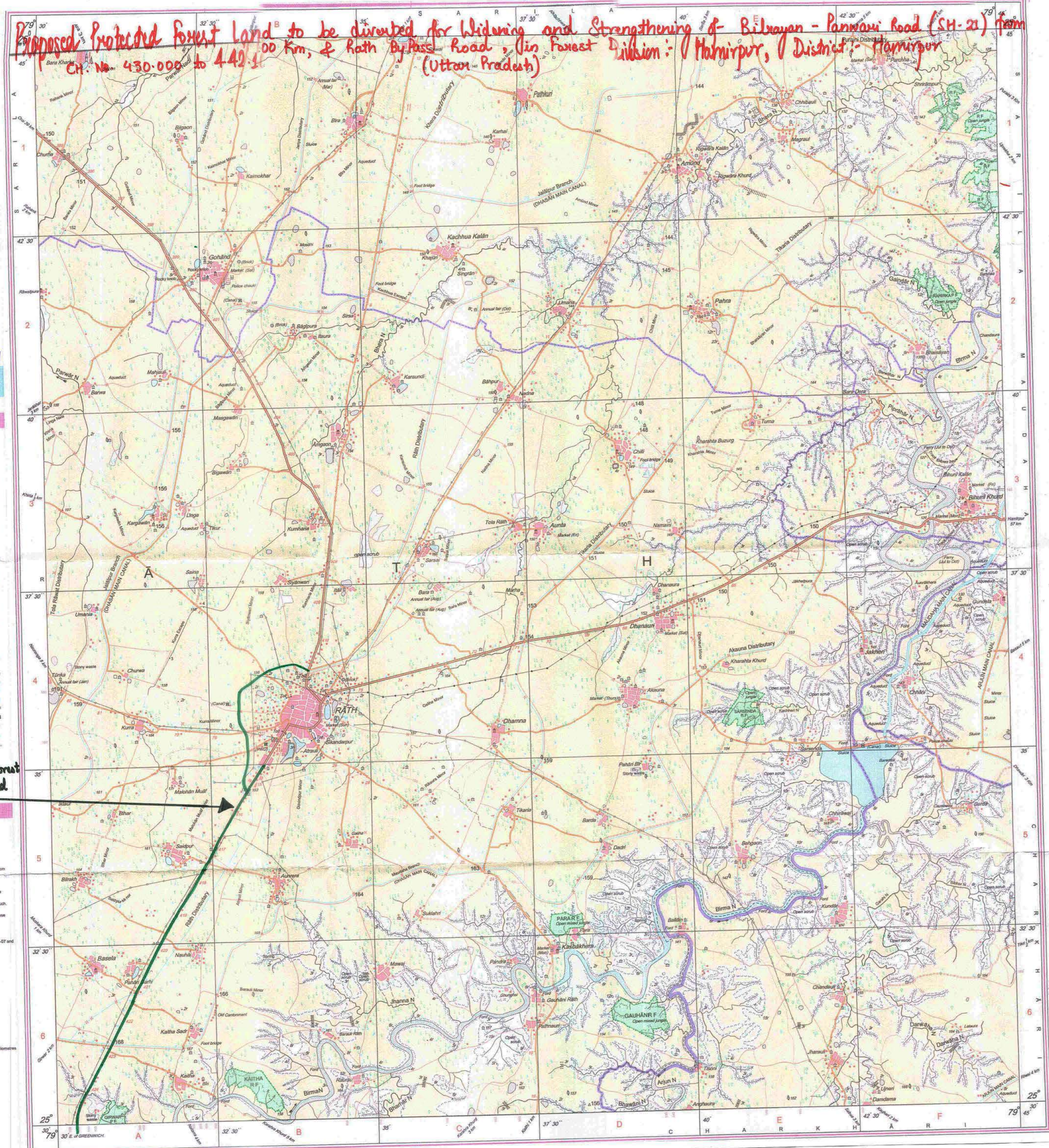
