It is submitted that, in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Government while  
communicating the in-principle/Stage-I approval accorded by the Gol, MoEF&CC,  
IRO, Vijayawada under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for  
diversion of 4.96 ha of forest land falling in Compartment no.200 of Bodabanda  
RF, Chittoor West Range, Chittoor West Division, Chittoor District in favour of M/s.  
Sri Vasista Mining, Hyderabad (Managing Partner- Sri B.S.Nithin Kumar Reddy) for  
grant of quarry lease for Black granite, requested to furnish compliance report for  
taking further action in the matter.

In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Chief Conservator of Forest (FAC),  
Ananthapuramu Circle, Ananthapuram has submitted the Stage-I  
compliance report. The Stage-I compliance report is as follows;

The area is having miscellaneous growth and is suitable for taking up SMC works like Check dams, MPTs, CCTs and gap planting. Further, the user agency has deposited an amount of Rs.35.60 lakh into A.P State CAMPA account no.1505968121204851 at Union Bank of India, Bangalore, dt.15.06.2023 (Copy enclosed).
(iv)	The State Forest Department shall raise and maintain plantation as proposed over an extent of 4.96 ha in the degraded forest land in Compartment No. 424 of Ramagiri East RF & Beat from the funds to be provided by the User Agency;	The CCF (FAC), Ananthapuramu Circle, Ananthapuram has reported that, the user agency deposited amount for raising and maintenance of plantations over an extent of 4.96 ha in the degraded forest area at the cost of the user agency which is included in the deposited amount of Rs.35.60 lakh by the User Agency (Shown as against condition no.3 of Stage-I approval)
(v). The total length of the boundary to be arrived is 1026.83 or 1027 Rmts as per the field book. 1027 Rmts of 2Mts width with 1.75 Mt depth.</p> <p>The Total quantity of earth work arrived 3594 cum (1027 Rmts x 2.00 x 1.75 Mt = 3594 cum).
