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It is submitted that, Government in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited have issued inprinciple Stage-1 approval for Diversion of **4.84 ha** forest land in compartment no.102, Janapadu RF, Palnadu Division for quarry lease for Limestone (Minor) in favour of Sri G. Pavan Kumar Reddy duly requesting to furnish compliance report on conditions stipulated therein.
