Please refer to your office letter under reference on the cited subject. It is to inform you that in-principle approval for forest clearance for Proposal No. FP/CH/ROAD/40667/2019 was granted vide letter dated 22.07.2019 (copy enclosed) with the approval of the competent authority for the diversion of 0.12 hectares of forest land at Khudda Lahora, UT Chandigarh, for the road leading to Janta Colony, Nagar Panchayat, Punjab.

- xii. Any other condition can be imposed by the Department of Forest & Wildlife, UT, Chandigarh, for the Conservation, Protection and Propagation of Forest & Wildlife from time to time.
