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

In context to this office letter dated 15th February, 2025 the Executive Engineer, (Road & Building), Public Works Department, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Silvassa has submitted the FRA Certificate as per the Condition No. A(6) vide letter dated 05.02.2025 of the Inprinciple approval granted vide letter dated 30th September, 2022 issued by the DIG &RO, IRO Gandhinagar.

The compliance of all the conditions are fulfilled by the User Agency the same is reproduced as under:




