Subject: Diversion of **0.7010 ha.** Wildlife Sanctuary area for setting-up the 4G communication tower location in village Mohbi, Janaraj, Vaghumar, Mathasar, Mandan, Dhirkhadi & Bhilvashi of Narmada District and OFC routes from Dumkhal to Mohbudi & from Surpan to Mathasar within Soolpaneshwar Wildlife Sanctuary in Narmada District in favour of Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd., Ahmedabad.

Kindly refer to your letter F.No. FC-6/GJB-106/2021-BHO/ dated 14.03.2022 on the subject cited above and it is informed that:-

Sr. No.	Condition	Compliance
A: Conditions which needs to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department:		
1	The cost of compensatory afforestation on the degraded CA land at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars, if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.	The User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.11,40,000/- towards the cost of Compensatory Afforestation in the CAMPA fund.



2	The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 0.701 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24/04/2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC (Pt.11) dated 18.09.2003, as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 and chapter 3 of FCA Handbook, 2019 in this regard.	The User Agency has already deposited an amount of Rs.47,56,671/- towards the cost of Net Present Value in the CAMPA fund. {Rs.9,51,334/- + Rs.38,05,337/-} {1 time NPV + 4 time NPV}
3	Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.	The User Agency has already given the undertaking in this regard.
4	The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.	FRA certificate of Collector, Narmada is attached herewith.
5	The proposed optical fiber cable is passing through Soolpaneshwar Wildlife Sanctuary. In this regard required Wildlife Clearance from Standing Committee of Wildlife shall obtained.	NOC issued by Chief Wildlife Warden, Gujarat State vide letter no. WLP/32/B/3858-63, Dt.11/11/2022 is attached herewith.
6	The working permission for the project shall be issued only after receiving of approval from Standing Committee of National Board of Wildlife (NBWL).	NOC issued by Chief Wildlife Warden, Gujarat State vide letter no. WLP/32/B/3858-63, Dt.11/11/2022 is attached herewith.
7	The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.	The User Agency has agreed
8	The KML files of diverted area and CA areas shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details prior to Stage-II approval.	The KML files of CA area is uploaded on the e-Green watch portal.



9	All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited in CAMPA fund only through e-portal.	Funds from the user agency has been transferred online to the CAMPA fund through e-portal.
B: Conditions which needs to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:		
1	Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.	The User Agency has Agreed
2	Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 2.00 ha. degraded forest land Survey no.408 Old (348 New), Village-Amalpani, Kalamkuva, Taluka-Dediyapada, Dist-Narmada, Gujarat at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and mono-culture of any species shall be avoided.	The User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.11,40,000/- towards the cost of Compensatory Afforestation, Survey demarcation in the CAMPA fund.
3	The Optical Fiber Cable shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after laying down of Cable the ground will be leveled.	The User Agency has Agreed
4	No tree felling shall be involved in the implementation of this project.	The User Agency has Agreed
5	No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.	The User Agency has Agreed
6	User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.	The Environment Clearance is not required for this project.
7	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.	The User Agency has agreed
8	No labour camp shall be establishment on the forest land.	The User Agency has agreed
9	Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.	The User Agency has agreed
10	The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.	The User Agency has agreed



11	No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.	The User Agency has agreed
12	The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.	The User Agency has agreed
13	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.	The User Agency has undertaken that the forest land shall not be used for any purpose, other than that specified in the FCA Proposal.
14	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.	The User Agency has agreed
15	The user agency shall submit the annual self compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government and Integrated Regional Office, Gandhinagar by the end of March every year.	The User Agency has agreed
16	The State Government and user agency shall comply the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, guidelines, NGT order & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.	The User Agency has agreed
17	Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violations of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as Para 1.21 of FCA, 1980 Handbook 2019.	The User Agency has agreed
18	Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.	The User Agency has agreed
