Subject: Diversion of **0.86125 ha.** Protected Forest land for road Widening and Strengthening of Segwa-Sinor-Malsar road Km.14/6 to 17/250 of Vadodara District in favour of Executive Engineer, District(R&B) Division, Vadodara.

With reference to your letter F.No. 6-GJB050/2018-BHO/952 dated 24.09.2019 on the subject cited above and it is informed that:-

1 Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged. 2 Forest land will be handed over to the user agency only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the user agency. 3 Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 2.00 ha. degraded forest land Survey no.81, Village-Runvad, Taluka-Chhotaudepur, District-Chhotaudepur, Gujarat at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species shall be avoided. 4 The cost of compensatory afforestation on the degraded CA land (17.00 ha.) at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars, if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority.
