1	The cost of compensatory afforestation on the degraded CA land (22.00 ha) at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme (including the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars, if required for securing the land against enrichment) shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.	1	The User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.1,18,02,225/- towards the cost of Compensatory Afforestation in the CAMPA fund.
