Subject: Diversion of 0.03374 ha. forest land for in favour of M/s Siddhi Vinayak Foods for access to Rice Milling & Trading of Food Grains etc. along Kaithal Road Km. stone 4-5 at Village Chandana, under Forest Division and Distt. Kaithal , Haryana. (FP/HR/Approach/140339/2021)

Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to the subject cited above mentioned proposal, in which the permission of the State Government has been sought under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam. 1980. In this regard, in-principle approval as granted by this office on dated 15.01.2025, Whose compliance report was received from Deputy Conservator of Forest, Kaithal vide letter number 13 dated 03.04.2025. In accordance with power delegated to Nodal Officer (FCA) by Govt. of Haryana vide order no.629-Ft-1-2024/1749 dated.15/03/2024 for diversion cases less than 0.1ha., **Final Approval** for the above-mentioned project is hereby granted subject to the following conditions:-

1. General Conditions

S. No	Conditions
1.1	<ol style="list-style-type: none">Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.The number of trees/plants to be felled shall not in any way exceed the number indicated in the proposal and no harm shall be done to the wildlife during felling of trees. The felling of trees/plants will be carried out under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the amount spent on felling of trees/plants will be deposited by the user agency to the State Forest Department.As per the proposed CA Scheme, Compensatory Afforestation (CA) shall be taken up by the State Forest Department over degraded forest land in Shergarh Minor RD 36-45 R/Side by planting 100 Plants at the cost of the user agency. The Plantation shall be done within one year from the date of issue of approval. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species shall strictly be avoided.

4. The compensatory plantation should be done within one year from the date of issue of this letter.
5. The Divisional Forest Officer shall upload the KML files of the degraded forest area accepted for raising compensatory afforestation in the E-Green watch portal of FSI, before handing over of forest land to the user agency.
6. The initial permission is given to this proposal for 99 years. After that the permission shall again be obtained from the Competent Authority.
7. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
8. The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased by the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Divisional Forest Officer will ensure that the increased amount is deposited.
9. No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land. Simultaneously, all efforts will be made to save adjoining forest and forest land.
10. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall, under no circumstances, be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Competent Authority.
11. No labor camp of any kind will be set up on forest land.
12. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Competent Authority under Van (Sanrakshan & Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980.
13. The user agency shall carry out muck disposal at pre-designated sites as per the scheme approved.
14. User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
15. Any other condition may be stipulated by Divisional Forest Officer from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
16. It will be the responsibility of the Divisional Forest Officer /User Agency to obtain all other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/ Court's Rulings/instructions, etc., including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal.
17. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC, consolidated guidelines and clarifications on Van (Sanraksh

2. Specific conditions

S. No	Conditions
2.1	The Competent Authority may suspend/cancel this approval if the implementation of any of the above conditions is not satisfactory. The Divisional Forest Officer will ensure compliance of these conditions.
2.2	This approval is in accordance with file approval of PCCF(HoFF) issued vide diary No. 7308 dated 19/03/2025, MoEF&CC(FC), Govt. of India, New Delhi letter dated 17.03.2025 and subject to the final outcome w.r.t. Hon'ble Supreme Court order in CWP (C) No. 1164/2023 dated 03/02/2025 and 04/03/2025.
