





In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) Dated: 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition) of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA,) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated: 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 1.505 hectares of forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of **construction of road from Bani to Billawar Via Dhaggar, Dhaman and Deri Gala under CRS Phase-I** -, in District Kathua. As per MoEF letter No. F.No. 11-9/98-FC (pt), Dated: 5th Feb. 2013 for linear projects like construction of roads, there is no requirement of resolution (meeting/consent) of Gram Sabha
